



## **Expectations:** Attendance



## Goal is <u>96%</u> attendance!

 Be ONLINE by 5-7 min to start of class...<u>No</u> Tardies!

#### • Stay FOR FULL CLASS BLOCK (4 Hours)

- Must be in school a minimum of 90% of the school year
- If absent 10% of year (18+ days), can be cited to the CUTS Program through the Juvenile Court.

# **Camera Expectations:** Keep ON

#### <u>Why??</u>

- Helps teachers to teach
- Know you're there...for learning!
- Builds community
- Hard to teach and interact with 'black boxes'



# **Remote Expectations: Bullying**



#### <u>Gateway Geckos will</u>:

- Not bully others
- Help students who are bullied

- Report bullying to an adult at school or at home

## **Remote Expectations: Clothing**

• Uniforms: Not required at this time

- <u>Not Appropriate</u>:
  - pajamas
  - Inappropriate pictures, logos, words, etc.
- <u>Student/Parent Contact</u>:
  - If there are issues, teachers will speak with students and parents first
  - If continues, teachers will contact Mr. Gutierrez or Dr. Roach




## Remote Expectations: Cell Phones (and other mobile devices)

- Personal devices are <u>NOT</u> to be used during class
  - We are using the honor system!



- If it continues to be a problem:
  - <u>1st offense</u>: Warning verbal, after class, or private chat message
  - <u>2nd offense:</u> **Student conference** within 24 hours
  - <u>3+ offenses</u>: **Parent conference** within 24 hours

# **Expectations:** iPads



#### Be Safe

Use appropriate school-related, approved sites
 Report unsafe behavior to an adult immediately

#### **Be Respectful**

- District property. You are borrowing to support your learning.
- Use during designated times.

#### **Be Responsible**

- Know where your device is at ALL times. You will pay if lost or damaged.
- $\circ~$  Keep off the ground and away from liquids



# 8th Grade Promotion Activities (May)

These events are **privileges that must be earned** by the student. Eligibility is based on the criteria described. School administration has the final decision.

# **Expectations:** Promotion

- Promotion Eligibility (Pt. 1):
  - Academics: The minimum is a D (60%) or higher after Quarter 1 - 4 report card grades are averaged for each of the four core academic subjects.
    - Must pass all four core academic subjects to qualify for the academic promotion certificate.

## GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) PROMEDIO DE CALIFICACIONES

To figure your <u>Grade Point Average (GPA)</u> we are using the following scales:

- A = 100 90% = Worth 4 pts
- B = 89 80% = Worth 3 pts
- C = 79 70% = Worth 2 pts
- D = 69 60% = Worth 1 pt

• F = 59 - 0% = Worth 0 pts

80% 90% 0% When these scores are averaged, you will have a 42% (F)

# **Expectations:** Promotion

### • <u>Promotion Eligibility (Pt. 2)</u>:

- <u>Behavior</u>: Students must maintain satisfactory citizenship and behavior.
- Students who have been suspended during Quarters 1-4 or have discipline referrals may lose promotion activities



# **Expectations:** Promotion

#### • <u>Promotion Eligibility (Pt. 3)</u>:

 <u>Attendance</u>: Students who are absent 10% or more of the school year, or 18 days, may lose promotion activities

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
