A TOTAL OF 16 INJURIES WERE REPORTED THROUGH THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR WITH 4 OF THE INJURIES RESULTING IN "LOST" TIME FROM WORK.

**CLEAN UP FALLEN LEAVES**

KEEP YOUR DRIVEWAY AND WALKWAY CLEAR OF FALLING LEAVES. WET LEAVES CAN CREATE A HAZARD FOR PEDESTRIANS IN THE FALL BY MAKING SIDEWALKS SLIPPERY.
