School District Legal Status

1. The legal basis for public education in the Towns of Chatham and Harwich is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Constitution of Massachusetts **and** state statutes pertaining to education, ~~and the Regional Agreement between the towns.~~
2. **Regional school districts are created in accordance with state law and the regional agreement approved by the member towns.**
3. **The Monomoy Regional School District exists through an agreement between municipalities under laws pertaining to education and under regulations of the Massachusetts Board of Education. The area served by the Monomoy Regional School District is identified in the Regional Agreement.**
