### CSI Student Achievement

#### Objectives

- The student body will demonstrate a 45% proficiency on the Spring assessment; a 15% proficiency increase from 30% on the Fall 2020 assessment.
- The student body will demonstrate a 40% proficiency on the Spring assessment; a 16% proficiency increase from 24% on the fall 2020 assessment.

#### Critical Initiatives

- All students will participate in extended learning for 30 additional minutes daily.
- Students not meeting proficiency with critical standards will receive reinforcement from 2 hours of supportive afterschool tutoring from 3-5 Monday-Thursday for 8 weeks or until 70

### Remote Learners

#### Objectives

- Teachers will utilize explicit instruction in order to ensure the learning of all remote students.

- Teachers will prepare lessons that will coincide with the standards and skills taken from our primary curriculum Acellus. Teachers will utilize effective teaching strategies to deliver instruction.
