### Free & Reduced-Price Meals

Free and reduced-price meals are available for students who qualify. Benefits must be renewed each year. If you have not recently received a letter of approval for this meal program, please apply through Skyward Family Access at sumnersd.org/familyaccess. Applications are also available at your child's school and online at sumnersd.org/mealapplication.



Note: The passage of House Bill 1238 provides meals at no cost for all students at Daffodil Valley (grades 1-5) and Liberty Ridge (grades K-5) elementary schools. Only these two schools met the threshold (above 40 percent students qualifying for free/reduced meals) to receive meals at no cost. HB 1238 only covers elementary schools; there are no provisions for middle or high schools.



### Waived/Reduced Fees

## **Limited Transportation: Inclement Weather Routes**

During inclement weather, there may be limited transportation, which means buses generally run on main roads rather than side streets or through neighborhoods. Driving a school bus in some areas, usually in Bonney Lake, may not be possible during severe weather. If limited transportation is in effect, some students must catch their bus at alternate stops. It is the responsibility of families to know if they live on an inclement weather route, which are noted below by zones with the alternate pick up and drop off


