

Free & Reduced-Price Meals

Free and reduced-price meals are available for students who qualify. Benefits must be renewed each year. If you have not recently received a letter of approval for this meal program, please apply through Skyward Family Access at sumnersd.org/familyaccess. Applications are also available at your child's school and online at sumnersd.org/mealapplication.



Note: The passage of House Bill 1238 provides meals at no cost for all students at Daffodil Valley (grades 1-5) and Liberty Ridge (grades K-5) elementary schools. Only these two schools met the threshold (above 40 percent students qualifying for free/reduced meals) to receive meals at no cost. HB 1238 only covers elementary schools; there are no provisions for middle or high schools.



Waived/Reduced Fees

Students who qualify for free and reduced-price meals or College Bound may be eligible for waived or reduced fees to participate in extracurricular school programs. Find the form necessary for eligibility at sumnersd.org/waivedfees.

Possible Bus Delays

Due to a continued bus driver shortage, it is highly likely that some bus routes will be affected to some degree on a daily basis. Any given route on any given day could experience a different bus number, earlier or later pick-up/drop-off times, and unfortunately the potential of no bus transportation at all. As soon as we know if your child's route is affected, we will send notification to families with as much advance notice we can give.



New Bus Route Lookup Tool

The district has a new tool that provides secure access to student bus stop locations, routes and schedules. Beginning Aug. 30, families can look up their child's bus information using the new tool. Go to sumnersd.org/buslookup for details.



New Communication Tool: ParentSquare

The district has launched ParentSquare, a new parent communication tool for robocalls, emails and text messages. If you've not yet activated your account, go to parentsquare.com/signin and follow the steps to register. Be sure and also download the mobile app in order to participate in two-way communication and additional features that will be rolled out over time.



Text Messages

Direct messages for private or group two-way communication. To receive texts, make sure your cell phone number is in Family Access.



Translation

Two-way, real-time translation supports over 100 languages. Allows district staff to communicate with families despite any language barriers.



Smart Alerts

One-way messages over email, text, and voice. It's "smart" because the message is first sent as a text. If text delivery fails, the system automatically delivers the recorded voice message.



Mobile App

Downloading the mobile app is the easiest way to receive all posts, events, photos, and files.

Inclement weather, power outages, hazardous road conditions

The decision to close or delay schools is made as early as possible, usually around 5 a.m. Early dismissals will occur only if delay in dismissal significantly increases hazards. Limited Transportation: Inclement Weather Routes

During inclement weather, there may be limited transportation, which means buses generally run on main roads rather than side streets or through neighborhoods. Driving a school bus in some areas, usually in Bonney Lake, may not be possible during severe weather. If limited transportation is in effect, some students must catch their bus at alternate stops. It is the responsibility of families to know if they live on an inclement weather route, which are noted below by zones with the alternate pick up and drop off stops.

Zone 1 Alternate Stops

- Sky Island/95th St Loop: Current bus stops along Sky Island Dr and at 184th Ave E at Sky Island Dr E and 97th St E at Sky Island Dr E
- Panorama Heights: Sky Island Dr E at 176th Ave E and Panorama Blvd E at Angeline Rd E
- Rhodes Lake Rd: No service between 171st Ave E at McCutcheon Rd E. Students will be picked up and dropped off at 171st Ave E at Rhodes Lk Rd or 96th St E at McCutcheon Rd E
- Ponderosa: South Prairie Rd E at 202nd Ave E and 210th Ave E at South Prairie Rd E
- Prairie Wood: 128th St Ct E at Ridgewood Dr E
- Walmart/192nd Ave E: Walmart parking lot
- Country Highlands: Rhodes Lk Rd at 195th Ave E
- Sumner ViewPoint: 78th St E at 166th Ave E

Zone 2 Alternate Stops

- Bankers Island: Lakeridge Dr at 45th St E
- Interlake Island: 193rd Ave E at West Tapps Dr E and 195th Ave E at 56th St E
- Behind Lakeridge/Rockwall: 64th St E at Myers Rd
- Church Lake Dr: Church Lk Dr E at West Tapps Hwy E and Vandermark Rd E at 214th Ave E
- Parkside South/Evergreen Dr: Evergreen Dr at Church Lk Rd and 197th Ave at Church Lk Rd E
- Lake Bonney Area: 77th St E at 182nd Ave E or 84th St E at 183rd Ave E, 84th St E at 184th Ave E, 185th Ave at 84th St E, and Bonney Lk Blvd E at 183rd Ave E

Zone 3 Alternate Stops

- Dieringer-Tapps Island: 214th
- Corner of O'Farrell Cutoff Rd at 112th St E
- Corner of Edwards at 210th Ave E
- Entrance of Driftwood and Deer Island: Sumner Tapps Hwy or Lake Tapps Elementary
- Forest Canyon and 166th Ave: Creator Lutheran Church at 166th Ave and South Tapps Dr E

Zone 4 Alternate Stops

- Sumner Heights: Old Cannery parking lot




