COMMUNICABLE DISEASES 1 2 3 The Alexandria City School Board recognizes the importance of protecting its students and employees from the transmission of communicable diseases that present a threat to their health 4 5 and safety, while also protecting the legitimate interests and rights of students and employees with communicable diseases. The Board directs the Superintendent to act in compliance with applicable 6 7 law to exclude from school attendance or work in the school setting any person who has a 8 communicable disease. Both the decision to remove the student or employee and the decision to 9 readmit the student or to permit the employee to return to work are made by the Superintendent or designee, usually the school nurse, based upon consultation with the local health department, the 10 student's or employee's physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse, and/or 11 other medical authorities. (See policy JHCCA - Blood Borne Contagious or Infectious Diseases). 12 The identity of a student who has a communicable disease is kept confidential and will be revealed 13 only in accordance with state law. An alternative educational program is made available to any 14 student whose removal pursuant to this policy is expected to result in a prolonged absence from 15 school or where otherwise required by law. 16 Administrative procedures concerning the exclusion of employees and students with 17 communicable diseases will be consistent with the requirements of law, including the policies of 18 19 the Virginia Department of Education, and should reflect current medical knowledge and research.
