

# **Graduation Requirements**

Students must complete the IB Middle Years Programme (Grade 9-10), and then either pass the Full IB Diploma or the U.S. Accredited ISP American High School Diploma (Grade 11-12). The American High School Diploma requires: participation and a passing grade in six courses, each from a different subject group, and participation in community service.

# **Limited University Applications**

ISP encourages students to complete extensive research in order to select their best-fit colleges and universities, and supports a maximum of 10 applications per student.

# **Grading System**

ISP utilizes the IB 1–7 grading scale, and does not report a Grade Point Average (GPA) or letter grades. ISP does not rank students.
