

ACT 155 (Now ACT 207) States:

A Person, who is no longer enrolled in a public school and has been denied graduation solely for failing to meet the exit exam requirements (S.C. Code Section 59-18-310 (B) (2), may petition the local school board of trustees to determine the student's eligibility to receive a high school diploma. The local school board will transmit diploma requests to the South Carolina Department of Education in accordance with this section shall not be counted as graduates in the graduation rate calculations for affected schools and districts, either retroactively or in current or future calculations.
