Dear families and staff of Parkway School:

We would like to update you on the water issues in the building.

Although the initial thought of simply adding a filtration system might have been a likely solution, we now have to move forward, in coordination with the Connecticut Department of Public Health and the certified operator of the water pump, to extend the well house located behind the school to allow for larger filters. While we are in communication with the Town of Greenwich Department of Public Works, it has now become a construction project and is currently in the process of design that will need additional funding of approximately \$400k.

Once the design has been completed and an interim for the funding has been submitted and approved, we expect it will take several months for the project to be completed, hopefully by spring.

Parkway continues to have a large supply of bottled water on hand for students and staff. There are water bottles available in each classroom and are free for students in the cafeteria during lunchtime. We have also appreciated staff and students bringing their own filled water bottles to school each day.

By following these precautions, we are confident that the staff and students at Parkway will be able to manage during the upcoming months until this project is completed and regular water usage is restored. Thank you for your continued support.
