Reporting Relationship: Reports to the Principal

Qualifications:

- Must be a mature evangelical Christian who agrees with the school's Statement of Faith and whose lifestyle is consistent with the school's Declaration of Moral Integrity
- Must be a member in good standing of a local evangelical church
- Must be able to articulate an understanding of a biblically informed philosophy of Christian education
- Must possess strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Must have a high school diploma or GED equivalent; a bachelor's degree is preferred
- Must pass a criminal background check through the Alabama State Department of Education
- Should have demonstrated experience in working effectively on teams of Christian professionals in meeting high academic and spiritual standards and goals

Scope of Responsibilities:

Substitute teachers hired by Briarwood Christian School are required to maintain the same standards and instructional standards as regular teachers. Specifically:

- Using lessons plans provided by the regular classroom teacher, teach, supervise, and direct students in grade(s) and subject(s) as defined by the administration in a manner consistent with a Christian education, the generally accepted standards of the teaching profession, and biblical standards of conduct and lifestyle
- To model and promote excellence in academic instruction and learning
- To provide Biblically integrated instruction consistent with the school Statement of Faith and Statement of Educational Philosophy
- To model a Christ-like lifestyle consistent with biblical principles of conduct
- To maintain a classroom environment conducive to learning
- To supervise students to ensure their safety in all activities
- To comply with and promote school policy
