- Maximize opportunities for site improvements

Program Needs and Existing Conditions

- Centralize student support services and create more welcoming environments for students, staff and families
- Upgrade to current building codes and environmental standards
- Modernize CTE/Art Classrooms
- Theatre Audio/Visual and Lighting Upgrades

- New two-story building with Administration, Counseling, and Classrooms at location of the existing buildings
- Reduce proposed building SF and maintain current building setbacks and site lines.
- Modernize CTE/Art Classrooms to enhance indoor and outdoor learning environments
- Repace Theatre A/V, lighting and sound systems with modern technology
- Maximize opportunities for site improvements

DISTRICT OFFICE

Program Needs and Existing Conditions

- ADA updates and repairs
- Provide adequate office spaces to meet staff needs
- Meeting spaces conducive for public engagement, i.e., community advisories, task forces, Board of Education meetings
- Increase meeting spaces available for collaboration & training
- Flexible and functional shared work spaces

Community Feedback

- Reduce size and scope of proposed projects
 - 12,000 SF of new building that fits within the <u>existing</u> <u>building locations</u>
- Do not increase available parking
- Considerations for traffic, light and noise
- Maintain existing rooflines
