FIRST SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE

- *Tuesday, December 20: 1st, 4th, and 5th Period*
- *Wednesday, December 21: 2nd, 6th, and 7th Period*
- *Thursday, December 22 (Half-Day, 11 AM Release): 3rd Period*

Seniors who received a score that was Proficient or Higher/Met or Exceeded Benchmark on the Spring 2022 MSTEP and PSAT on 3 out of the 4 will be exempt from all exams for the first semester. Exempt students may take the exam to achieve a higher final grade if they choose to.
