Instructions for Families on the Use of a Learning Management System (LMS)

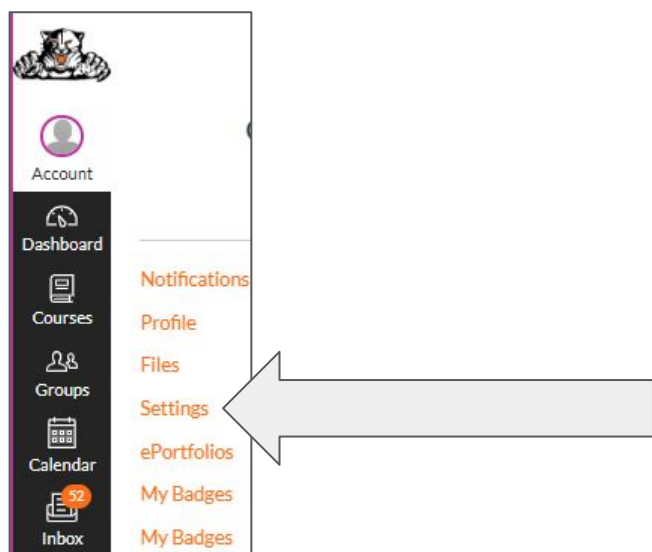
This fall, your child will access instruction through a learning management system (LMS). An LMS is an online platform that includes course content, instructional videos, and class assignments. Teachers will use an LMS to give students feedback and grade assignments. Students grades 6-12 in the Verona Area School District will use Canvas for the LMS.

Step 1: Obtain a unique pairing code from your student.

Have your student log into Canvas using the app on their iPad or by typing vasd.instructure.com into a web browser. From a web browser, they will log in with their school google account.

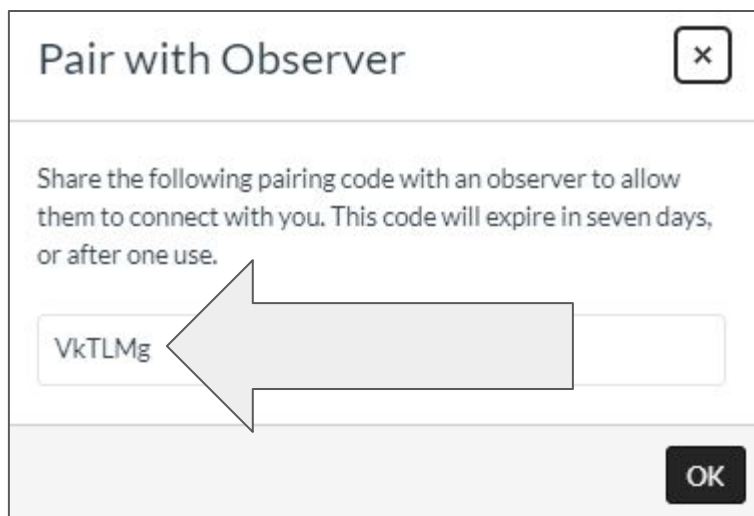
Your student should click "Account" in the upper right hand corner. Then they should click "Settings."



Next, click Pair with Observer on the right side of the screen.



Finally, write down the pairing code.



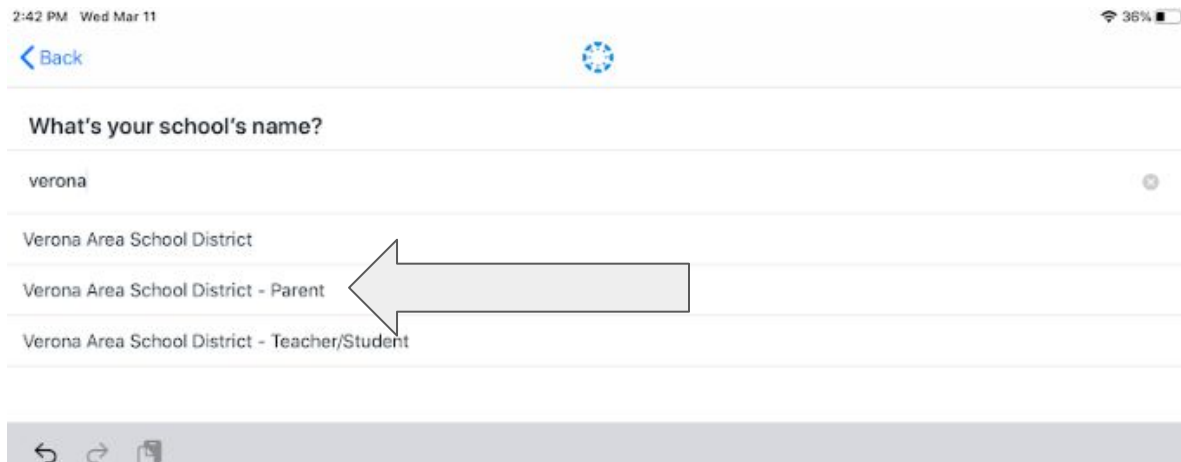
Step 2: Download the Canvas Parent App from the App Store or Google Play store.



Step 3: Once the app is installed, click on the Canvas Parent App.

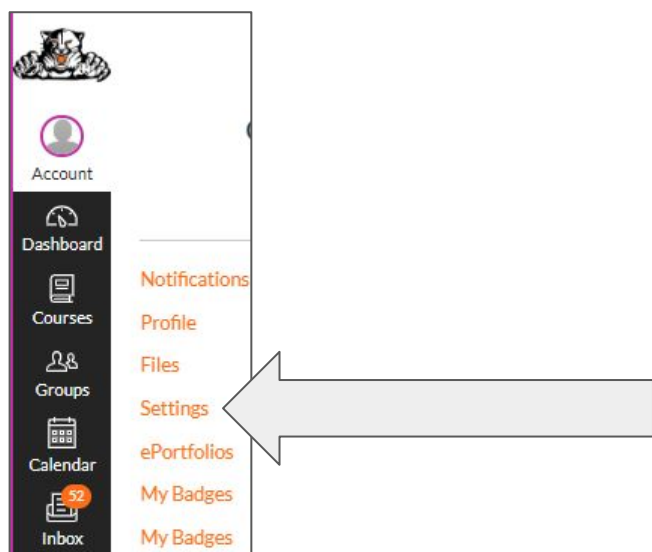

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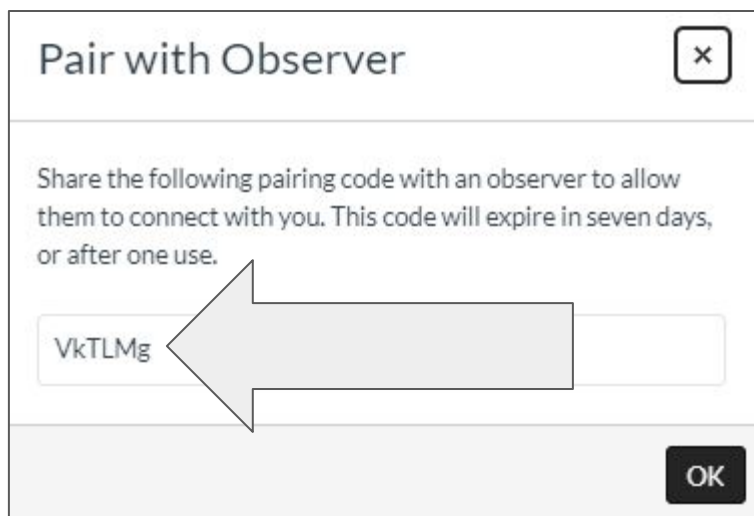
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
Next, click Pair with Observer on the right side of the screen.



Finally, write down the pairing code.



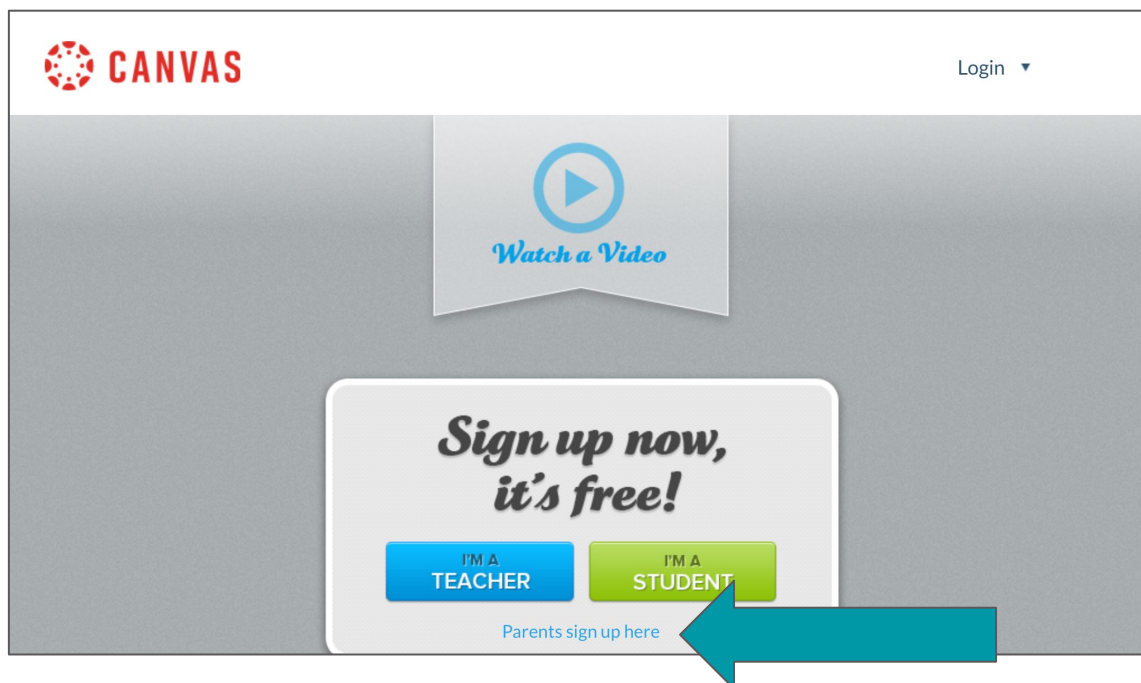
Step 2: Go to <https://vasd.instructure.com/login/canvas>.
