

Diabetes

Definition:

Diabetes is a disease that affects levels of sugar in the blood. Some diabetics take insulin, which can cause low blood sugar.

Signs of low blood sugar:

- Change in behavior, such as confusion or irritability
- Sleepiness
- Hunger, thirst
- Sweating, pale skin color
- Seizure

Treatment in case of low blood sugar:

If the person can swallow, give him something to eat/drink that contains sugar, such as fruit juice, milk, sugar, honey, and soft drinks.
