
STARTING OUR DAY WITH THE THREE Rs

AM CAR LINE



NEW! At 7:20 am each morning, or after all buses have left campus, the CES bus loop will be opened for car drop-off for <u>PK and Kindergarten students and their siblings only</u>. The main car line is still an option if preferred, or before 7:20.
Families who have a CES PK and/or Kindergarten student may also drop off their CIS student in this line. Please always wait until all buses have cleared. No vehicle should pass around a parked school bus at any time.
