

2nd Grade Learning Packet How-to's

Everyday students should complete the following tasks:

1. Read 30 minutes
 - EPIC (teachers will email their class code)
 - Reading A-Z (teachers will enroll students and send login information)
 - Choose a book
2. Complete 1 math Problem of the Day.
3. Do 20 minutes of prodigy math and choose 1 item from the math choice board.
4. Choose 1 item from the Science/SS choice board
5. Choose 1 item from the ELA choice board
6. Work on this week's writing topic

Writing: Students will be working on the same writing all week. If they are finished, they can revise and edit their writing. They can also begin a new story if they have finished. Ideally, students will be writing about the same topic all week.

Week of March 16 - 20: Realistic fiction is a story that could happen in real life. Write a realistic fiction story that you will work on all week. Use the writing process you have learned about since kindergarten to write a beginning, middle and end. Remember to describe your character, tell what the characters do to solve the problem. Include dialogue (what characters say) and how characters feel. Edit your story for spelling and punctuation then read it to someone else.

Week of March 23 - 27: Opinion writing is sharing your opinion about a topic. Write an opinion writing that you will work on all week. Students can write their opinion on the following prompt: What is the best pet? Remember to clearly state your opinion. Include at least 3 reasons why you have that opinion and include an ending. Edit your story for spelling and punctuation then read it to someone else.

Social Studies/Science Use the choice board to choose a daily assignment.

Math Use the choice board to choose a daily assignment.

ELA: Use the choice board to choose a daily assignment
