This email is being sent as a follow-up to handwritten questions you submitted during the "Public Participation" portion of the June 12 meeting of the Trustees of School District 5 of Lexington and Richland Counties. Responses are posted below.

- 1) What type of coordination is taking place between Lex./Rich. Dist 5 & Lexington County Comprehensive Plan Update?

The District is always eager to work in partnership with the County as requested or as appropriate. To our knowledge, no requests for "coordination" have been submitted to the District.

- 2) In relation to the proposed Amicks Ferry Rd. Elem. School site. How many current students would attend a school at this site & how many of these families have children attending the middle/Intermediate/High Schools?

It is not possible – nor is it appropriate – for the district to address possible attendance for a proposed new school site.

- 3) What other sites are being considered for a new Elem. School? Several sites have been suggested.
