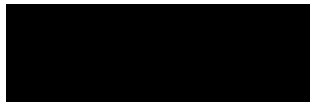

This letter is written as a follow-up to the questions you asked during the "Public Participation" portion of the May 8, 2017 meeting of the Trustees of School District 5 of Lexington and Richland Counties.


You asked, *"What additional infrastructure will be needed on the 2 tracks of land on Amicks Ferry?"*

Answer: There is currently a 12 inch water main and a 12 inch force sewer main on the property. That infrastructure is available. As a part of school construction, the South Carolina Department of Transportation may require some roadway improvements, which the District will complete as a component of any school construction project on the site.

You asked, *"Can the district provide in writing what approvals have been granted so far to date on the Amicks Ferry land?"*

Answer: No. Due diligence is in process at this time. Once due diligence has been completed, the Administration will make a determination as to whether or not to recommend the Board proceeds to purchase the property pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §59-19-180. If the Administration recommends purchasing the property, due diligence information will become publicly available after the transaction is closed.
