### Attention 10th, 11th, and 12th Graders: ASVAB Test Opportunity at Fairview High School!



Hello 10th, 11th and 12th graders,

Fairview will be hosting the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) test in the Fairview library on Wednesday, October 11 at 8:30 am. Anyone in 10th, 11th or 12th grade is welcome to sign up for this free test for any of the following reasons:

- to identify potential careers
- to discover all the pathways to career-field entry
- to learn about your skills and interests
- to pass state mandated performance measures in math and English
- to gauge your military aptitude

Per the last bullet, if you're thinking of joining the military, you'll want to take this test, but please know you may take the ASVAB even if you are <u>not</u> interested in joining the military as the information you learn about career matches can be especially helpful for future planning. <u>Here's</u> more information about the ASVAB Career Program.

Per the second to last bullet, the state of Colorado requires that all graduating seniors pass certain performance measures in math and English, both of which can be assessed via the ASVAB (please note: performance measures can also be evaluated via a variety of other assessments listed <u>here</u>). Why not start early? Even 10th or 11th graders can take the ASVAB, earn certain scores, and get these performance measures out of the way!

The ASVAB is a self-paced, paper & pencil test which takes around 3 hours. You'll be excused from your morning classes in order to take the test.
