TOP TIPS FOR STAYING SAFE THIS

HALLOWEEN

BE FIRE SAFE

- Never leave candles unattended
- Keep clear of flames which could cause costumes to catch fire
- Make sure your costume has a CE or UKCA mark on the label



STOP, DROP & ROLL

If your clothing were to ever catch fire, remember to:

- STOP** what you are doing.
- DROP** to the floor
- ROLL** from side to side to extinguish the flames.

DON'T GO OUT ALONE!

Going trick or treating? Make sure you go with an adult and that your parent/carer knows when you're going to and when to expect you home. Stay with your group too.



RESPECT OTHERS

Halloween isn't fun for everyone. If you see posters asking you not to trick or treat, please don't.
