National Administration of ACT for all 11th - Spring - Required as part of accountability for state assessment and utilized by colleges and universities for admissions. Individual Score reports are provided to students.

SAAB- Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery - Administered to 10th and 11th grade students who voluntarily choose to take the assessment. ASVAB is used to determine qualification for enlistment in US armed forces. Individual score reports are provided to students.

MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) Assessment – Universal screener used to inform instruction and determine interventions on an individual student basis. Administered in fall and spring

7th – Reading and Math - Map universal screener used to inform instruction and determine interventions on an individual student basis. Administered in fall and Spring Individual score reports are provided to students and review by teachers. The length of the assessment is determined by individual student performance.

8th— Reading and Math - Map universal screener used to inform instruction and determine interventions on an individual student basis. Administered in fall and Spring Individual score reports are provided to students and reviewed by teachers. The length of the assessment is determined by individual student performance

10th- Reading and Math - Map universal screener used to inform instruction and determine interventions on an individual student basis. Administered in fall and Spring Individual score reports are provided to students and reviewed by teachers. The length of the assessment is determined by individual student performance

11th- Reading and Math - Map universal screener used to inform instruction and determine interventions on an individual student basis. Administered in fall and Spring Individual score reports are provided to students and reviewed by teachers. The length of the assessment is determined by individual student performance

PREP – State required assessment administered every spring. Results are used at the Kentucky Dept. of Education to determine accountability for each school and school district. Grade levels and core content assessed at each grade is included in attached chart. PREP results are received in the fall and individual score reports are sent home to parents. SEE CHART ATTACHED.
