6. Math Instruction

- Feedback
 - Questions need to be less procedural and more conceptual
 - Strengthening of Bar Modeling
- Plan of Action
 - Working through Professional Development using
 - The Elements of Good Math Instruction
 - The Singapore Model Method for Learning Mathematics
 - July 27-28 Singapore Math (grades K-7, ESE, upper math) @St John's
 Classical & August 1, 2 IEW (grades 3-8, ESE)
 - Using Master teachers within our school to model math lessons
 - Identify specific teachers that need extra support and connecting them with our math coach for weekly coaching

7. Literature, Science and History Instruction

- Feedback
 - Simplify Lesson Plans
 - Rely on richness of content through read alouds and excellent questioning rather than intensive lesson plans full of activities and worksheets
 - Provide more hands on Science Instruction
- Plan of Action
 - Explicitly train from Hillsdale's Box Resources
 - Reading a Story With your Students-Literature
 - What a History Class Looks Like- History
 - Library of Labs-Science

1. General Recommendations

- Feedback
 - Uniforms-tightening up on uniform policies
 - Fit of outerwear
 - Skirt length
- Plan of Action
 - Teachers should enforce at the beginning of period and should be clear on how to handle uniform infractions.
- Feedback
 - Constant flow of students leaving classrooms during instruction for restroom breaks
- Plan of Action
 - Encourage students to use restrooms between classes and outside of classroom instruction
- Feedback
 - Students eating during instruction. No time limit or amount of food given to students causing them to not focus on instruction
- Plan of Action
 - Provide a given time and place limits on snacking in upper school

Continued

- Feedback
 - More presence of teachers in hallways during upper school transition
- Plan of Action
 - Administrative presence and holding teachers accountable for this responsibility
- Feedback on Scheduling
 - Upper School Teachers teach 5 classes and have 2 preps
 - This has not been the practice for the past few years. The amount of grading and ability to plan high level instruction requires time for planning.
- Plan of Action
 - Work with Upper School Dean and Principal to work toward this recommendation
