If you are having difficulty accessing reports, try these steps. Please note, this task is easier on a desktop or Chromebook:

- Log onto the parent portal.
- Click on your child's ID # (in blue).
- On the new page the top row in reads, "Assessment"; click on that but <u>maximize the screen</u>.
- On the new page click the Parent Assessment Report tab.
- Then click on the double arrow at the top left side to expand the choices.
- A menu will appear on the left side, it will state NWEA, but below that is the NYS Reports.
- Click on the NYS assessments.
