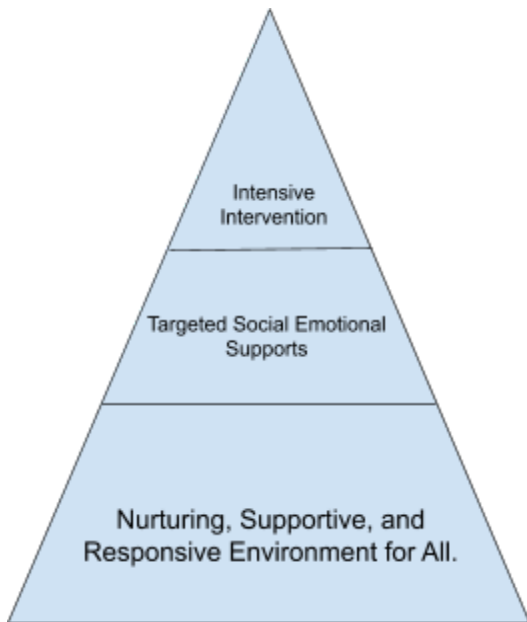


Pyramid Model

What is the Pyramid Model?

The Pyramid Model is a way to provide different levels of support to help your child develop play skills, self-control skills, and to help them learn about their feelings.

What is gained by using the pyramid model?

- Families learn ways to support their child's social and emotional skills
- Team with providers to help children grow and learn
- Receive support to prevent and address any behavior concerns
- Children develop their social and emotional skills
