What is the Maryland Report Card?

- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), 2015
- Accountability for student performance determined by states
- Last measure in 2019 School Year
- New data from 2022
- Provides measures to identify challenges and success
- Linked to School Improvement Plans
