



The Literacy Block in Grade 5

In grade 5, our goals are to:

1. continue building students' general, content-specific, and academic vocabulary;
2. enable students to decode and spell multisyllabic words by using syllable patterns and morphology;
3. foster students' ability to write better sentences and coherent essays
4. enable students to demonstrate comprehension in text-based responses to what they read and what is read aloud to them;
5. prepare students to learn from nonfiction texts in content subjects by understanding their structures;
6. provide students with many opportunities to extend their fluency and comprehension proficiency in texts of increasing complexity; and
7. foster a love of reading and writing.
