

NORTH EAST HIGH SCHOOL TARDY TO SCHOOL POLICY

Being punctual means arriving on time to fulfill one’s responsibilities. Employers expect that employees will arrive and be ready to start work on time. North East High School students demonstrate respect, responsibility, and readiness to learn in several ways. The first is to be on time to school and class. It is the expectation that all students are on time. When students do not fulfill this expectation, specific consequences will be assigned as a way to modify their behavior.

1	Verbal Warning
2	Warning (email from Attendance Secretary to student and parent)
3	Warning (email from Attendance Secretary to student and parent)
4	Twilight Detention (1 day) (ODR) and Parent Phone Call
6	ODR - Twilight Detention (2 days) and Possible Suspension of Driving Privileges
8	MIP (ODR) and Revoked Driving Privileges - Parent Phone Call
10+	SST referral, NEHS Tardy to School Letter, and ODR with further disciplinary consequences

GET YOUR PASS TO GET TO CLASS

Students are expected to be in their First Period class when the late bell sounds. All classroom doors will be locked at the sound of the late bell. Students arriving late must report to the attendance office to sign in and receive a pass to gain entrance to class. **Students who are not in their assigned classroom by 7:40 AM or who report to school before 11:00 AM without an excuse are considered tardy and are subject to the above disciplinary actions.**
