DOES DUOLINGO REALLY WORK?

Language is one of the most important tools a human can have, as it allows us to communicate with other humans around the world. This exact reasoning is what drives most people to learn a foreign language; they want to be able to communicate with more people and, more specifically, native speakers of the language they are learning. With this in mind, many people look to the greatest resource of all to learn that language: the internet. On the internet, you can find resources to learn to speak, read, write, or listen to your target language. Some sites, like Duolingo, even promise to help you become fluent in all four key aspects of that language. Duolingo – likely thanks to the fun and easy approach to learning a language – has become the world's most popular language learning app. Due to its popularity, it has a crowd of critics with opinions ranging from outright disgust with Duolingo, to complete adoration for the app, and each side has good reasons for their opinions.

Duolingo is a free language learning app and website that allows users to learn a multitude of languages, including constructed (or made-up) languages. The site mainly targets English speakers who seek to learn another language, but there are many courses that natives of other languages can take. As the world's most downloaded language learning app, that little green owl definitely has some standards to live up to...but does it live up to them?

The courses Duolingo does offer vary in terms of how fluent they will help you to become. For example, while the Spanish course for English speakers has over 200 units, the course for Russian from English has a mere 51, with some languages offering even fewer units. While this is reasonable, as the company offers so many courses that they are forced to work on them in order of popularity, this is a dramatic difference in achievable fluency, and can be discouraging, at least, for someone who wants to learn a less popular language like Russian instead of a more popular language like Spanish. This, however, is the least of the problems that Duolingo critics have with the app.

In a survey of Rising Sun High School students, 84 of 90 students surveyed responded to a question asking their opinions on the app. A large majority of the respondents said that Duolingo is effective and many said it should be supplemented with other language learning materials to be effective, but only a handful said that it is not effective whatsoever. The general consensus among RSHS students, as well as a large number of people elsewhere, seems to be that Duolingo is not effective for long-term growth. In 500 Days of Duolingo: What You Can (and Can't) Learn From a Language App (5/25/19), Eric Ravenscraft argues that, "...if you want to become fluent in a language...[Duolingo] won't be enough..." Ravenscraft believes that while it might help you learn the basics, it is not to be used as a replacement for a language course, and it will definitely not help you much, if you wish to pass a language proficiency or biliteracy test; basically, Duolingo promises too much. Some, however, offer a different perspective.

From the perspective of someone who needs a quick, cost effective way to learn a language, Duo just so happens to be a popular refuge. Although Duo may not be able to teach you how to pass a biliteracy test, some argue that you don't exactly need a biliteracy certificate to be able to communicate effectively. For example, it is not uncommon for native speakers of a language to avoid the grammar, syntax, advanced vocabulary, and formality rules that these tests tend to focus on. (How often do you say something like "should of" instead of "should've" or "should have" when you speak, even formally? What about "yeah" or "uh-huh" instead of "yes?") After all, "The people behind the [Duolingo] courses are real speakers of the language..." says Cindy Blanco, part of the Duolingo team, in "Can Duolingo Make Me Fluent?" and Other Common Questions from Learners (8/3/2022), so why would Duolingo not be able to teach you a language?

Well the answer to that question is quite simple, according to many users: it can! While Duolingo might work best in combination with other language learning tools, it is quite an easy and reliable way to get your feet off the ground, and begin your language learning journey. In fact, according to an independent study conducted by the City University of New York and the University of South Carolina, an average of 34 hours of Duolingo are equivalent to a full university semester of language education! This is quite unbelievable, but the numbers speak for themselves: people who learn a language on Duolingo are able to communicate more efficiently and sooner than people who take university courses!

So is that little green owl the greatest foreign language teacher in the world, or are they a fraud? That is a question which you must answer for yourself, as every person has their own learning preferences. With that being said, however, if you just want to be able to communicate effectively with speakers of your target language, evidence suggests that Duo might make a pretty good teacher.



Guatemala native and Carnegie Mellon University (CMU) professor Luis von Ahn decided that he wanted to dedicate his work to transforming education – leading him to cofound Duolingo with the mission of bringing free language education to the world.

Duolingo was opened to the public on June 19, 2012, with a waiting list of 500,000 who wanted to use the app.

Recipe #5: Animal Cell Cookies! Microbiologists will love this! Yowza!

Ingredients:

- Pillsbury sugar cookie dough
- Writing icing

Steps:

1. Cut your cookie dough into circles. We cut ours about half an inch thick and they came out pretty big, so cut them thinner if you'd like them to be smaller.

2. Arrange your cookies on your pan with parchment paper. Make sure they are spaced apart!

3. Bake the cookies according to the directions on the packaging.

4. When they are done cooking, wait for them to cool before applying your icing. If you want to make plant cells (which are more rectangular than animal cells), cut the cookies into rectangles before they fully cool.

5. Use different colors of icing to draw the different parts of the cell, like the nucleus, membrane, ribosomes, and mitochondria! Make sure to give your plant cells chloroplasts!
