What is King County Promise?

King County Promise (KCP) is a program that centers on ensuring prioritized high school students, Opportunity Youth, and community and technical college students are provided holistic and comprehensive postsecondary advising to support attainment of a postsecondary credential. The KCP model relies on Promise Partnerships strengthening alignment and collaboration across K-12 districts/high schools, CBOs, and CTCs to support students through the milestones outlined below. Promise Partners will co-design and implement a KCP service delivery plan, aligned with existing postsecondary strategies, to support their prioritized student populations.
