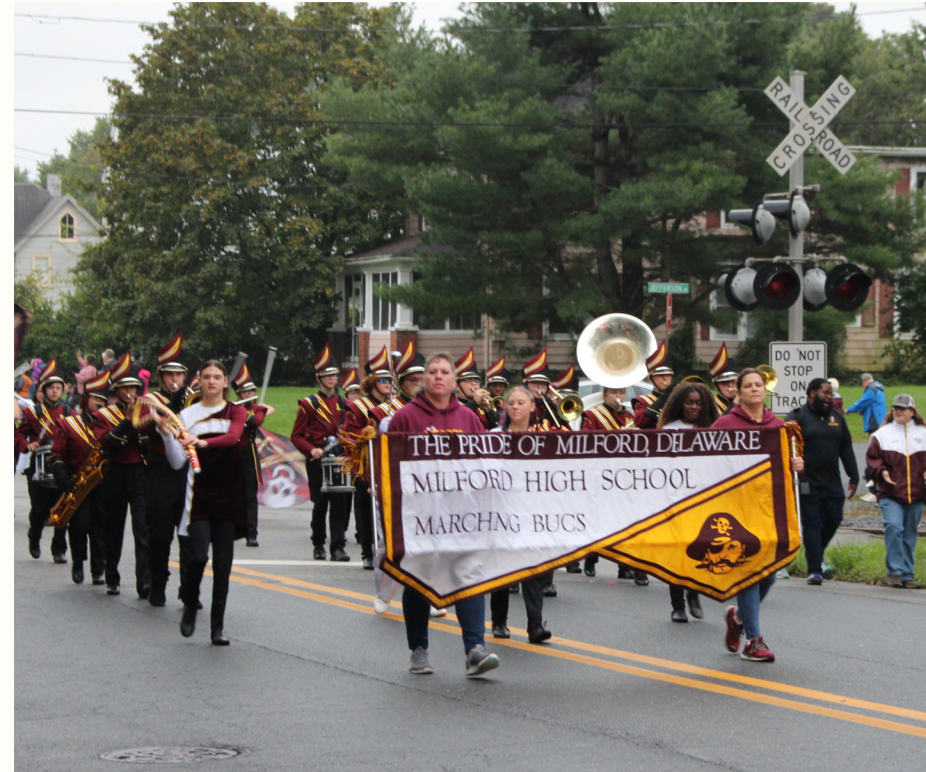

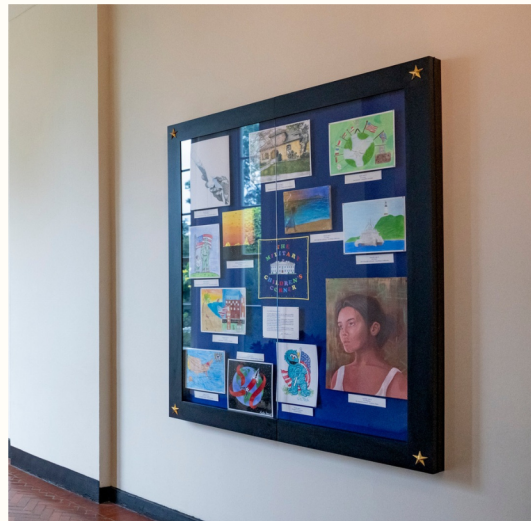


STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

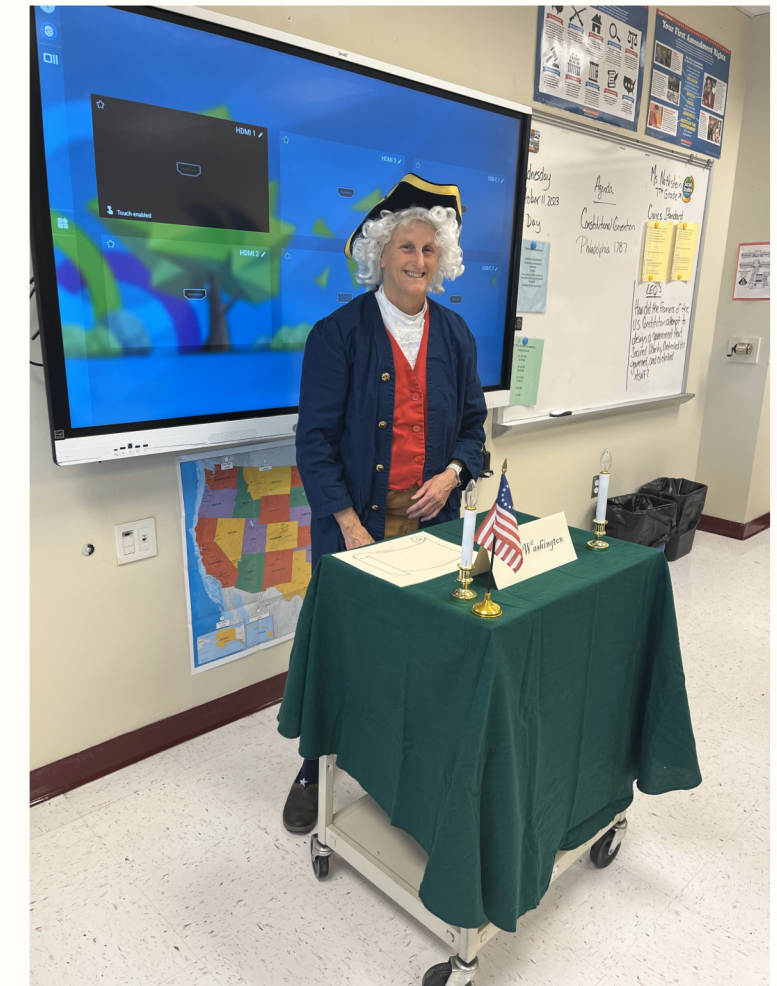

Doors open at 5:30pm and line ends at 7:00pm


Who: For children ages 12 and under

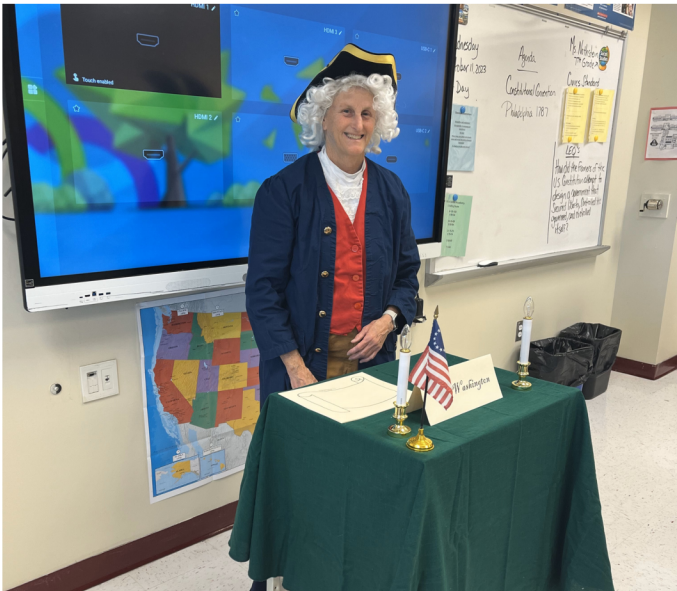
