Dear Parent/Carer,

Uniform consultation for adjustment using PE kit.

We hope that your child has settled well into the start of the new academic year. Although we are approaching the winter term at present, we are keen to plan and look towards the Spring and Summer terms. With this in mind, we would like to take this opportunity to consult with parents and carers around the idea of utilising our school PE kits on days where there are significantly higher temperatures forecast. This initiative would not replace the use of non-blazer days but would be utilised on days where the weather is consistently forecast to be 25°C or above for part of the school day. Our aim is always to create an environment that is conducive to learning for our students and we are working on this consultation based on staff, student, and parent feedback.

The proposal that we would like to consult on, is that all students would wear their school PE kit instead of their uniform on the days identified as meeting the above criteria by the Headteacher. Parents and students would be informed of this decision no later than the day before students are required to wear their PE kit.

We would like to gather your feedback around this proposal to further inform our decision-making process.
