

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND  
THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE  
OCEANSIDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Oceanside Unified School District (“District”) intends to amend Board Bylaw No. 9270, the District’s Conflict of Interest Code (“Code”) pursuant to Government Code section 87306.

The proposed amendment clarifies the procedure for filing statements of economic interests and the District’s obligations regarding the submission of said statements filed by persons holding specific positions to the Clerk of the San Diego County Board of Supervisors, the obligation to make said statements available for public inspection and reproduction, and retention of the same.

Additionally, the Appendix of the Code designates those employees, members, officers, and consultants who are subject to the disclosure and disqualification requirements of the District’s Code. The District’s proposed amendment includes new positions that must be designated and revises titles.

The proposed amended Code will be considered by the District’s Board of Trustees at its meeting on October 13, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Due to COVID-19, the meeting will take place virtually and is accessible via live video at <https://zoom.us/j/97588270643> or via teleconference at **1-669-900-9128 (Webinar ID: 975 8827 0643#)**.
