

## School Improvement

School Improvement is a decision-making model that schools utilize to ensure programming, teaching and learning, and culture and community, provide all students access, opportunity, and support to achieve at high levels.

Each school develops a School Improvement Plan (SIP). The SIP identifies priority goals, instructional and culture strategies, and supports schools will implement to raise student achievement and prepare students for college and career pathways.

This works starts at the elementary school and continues through high school.

## ELA and Math for College and Career Readiness

Data Summary:

MCAP – improvement in scores for students in FARMS and Special Education. There is room for improvement in the general population overall.

Graduation Rate – We have graduation rate over 90%.



Collaborative Planning Meetings for English, Math, Social Studies, and Science teachers weekly. Opportunities for students to receive tutoring during Saturday School, HERD, and FEV.

Professional Development on cross-content writing scaffolds, such as MEALS and UDL tools.

## Early College/Dual Enrollment/AP/CTE

Data Summary:

AP Enrollment – AA population increased, but number of test-takers did not Graduation Rate – Over 90% on time with cohort Matriculation – Increase in 9<sup>th</sup> graders moving onto 10<sup>th</sup> grade



- By the end of the 2023-24 SY, enrollment for AP Early College/Dual Enrollment/AP/CTE will increase by 5% for both ELL and African-American students by engaging students in prerequisite classes using Universal Design for Learning: Affective Network and MEALS scaffolding to support academic writing in all content classrooms.
- Collaborative Planning Meetings for CTE during HERD focused on supporting writing in technical subjects
   CTE/AP Recruitment Fairs for students



### Climate and Culture

Data Summary:

Support Strategy Assessment (mock guided visit)— implementation of restorative approaches needed.

Referral – room for improvement from school year 21-22 to 22-23.



- By the end of the 2023-24 SY, discipline data will show a decrease of 10% in office referrals through the use of PBIS reinforcement, Restorative Practices use in classrooms, and mentoring of new classroom teachers to deescalate behavior issues and provide guidance to students on self-regulation strategies that help students monitor their own behavior.
- Restorative Practice Trainings targeting staff and MHS students
  - Quarterly Discipline Data Discussions with Faculty and PBIS incentives.






