**RESOLUTION NO. 24 (19-20) ADDING PROPERTY FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE  
FACILITIES ADVISORY (7-11) COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Oceanside Unified School District ("District") owns real property located at 333 Garrison Dr., Oceanside, California ("Garrison Elementary School"), more specifically identified as follows: County of San Diego Assessor's Parcel Numbers ("APN") 162-020-24-00 and 162-030-14-00;

**WHEREAS**, the District Governing Board ("Board") has the responsibility of managing its property assets and is given authority under Education Code § 17455 to dispose of property not needed for school purposes;

**WHEREAS**, Education Code section 17388 requires that the Board appoint a District facilities advisory committee ("7-11 Committee") to advise the Board regarding the use or disposition of such real property;

**WHEREAS**, on May 14, 2019, the Board adopted and approved Resolution No. 23 (18-19) to establish a 7-11 Committee to review and consider whether other District properties located at the (1) Pacifica Elementary School Site and (2) Oceanside Shores High School site should be declared surplus property;

**WHEREAS**, on November 12, 2019 the Board adopted and approved Resolution No. 09 (19-20) adding two additional properties for 7/11 Committee consideration: (1) Ditmar Cottage and (2) Pioneer Cemetery.

**WHEREAS**, the Board expressly provided in Resolution No. 23 (18-19) that the Board could add other District properties to the list of properties for the Committee's consideration at a later date; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board now desires to have the 7-11 Committee review and consider whether Garrison Elementary School, which constitutes 11.25 acres of land, should be declared surplus property; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the above recitals are true;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Board directs the 7-11 Committee to consider whether Garrison Elementary School should be considered potential surplus property.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Board directs the Committee to comply with Education Code section 17387 et seq., including providing hearings for community input and making recommendations for uses of surplus space and real property to the Board.
