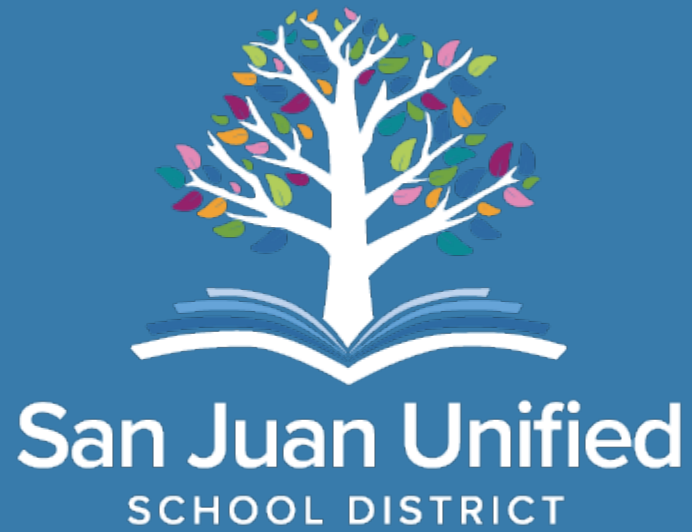
Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Overview





LCAP PAC Charge and Function

- The LCAP PAC is considered one of multiple educational partners which the superintendent and board consults with and seeks advice from in the development and revision of the LCAP.
- As directed by the board, superintendent or designee, the committee shall “consult” and provide “advice” to the Board of Education on matters pertaining to the LCAP as specified in Education Code section 52063.
- *“Consult” [Education Code section 52060(g)] and “advice” [Education Code section 52063(a)(1)] are defined as:*
 - *District gathering the perspectives and insights of educational partners as they relate to the LCAP through the district educational partner engagement strategy, which includes surveys and listening sessions.*
 - *LCAP PAC reviewing and providing comment on the development of the LCAP pursuant to Section 52062(a)(1).*



Engagement Strategy

- California Education Code requires that districts shall “consult with teachers, principals, administrators, other school personnel, local bargaining units of the school district, parents, and pupils in developing a local control and accountability plan.” [Section 52060(g)]
- SJUSD’s educational partner engagement strategy:
 - Aligned to and meets education code requirements
 - Focused on increasing engagement of our EL, LI, FY, and HM student groups

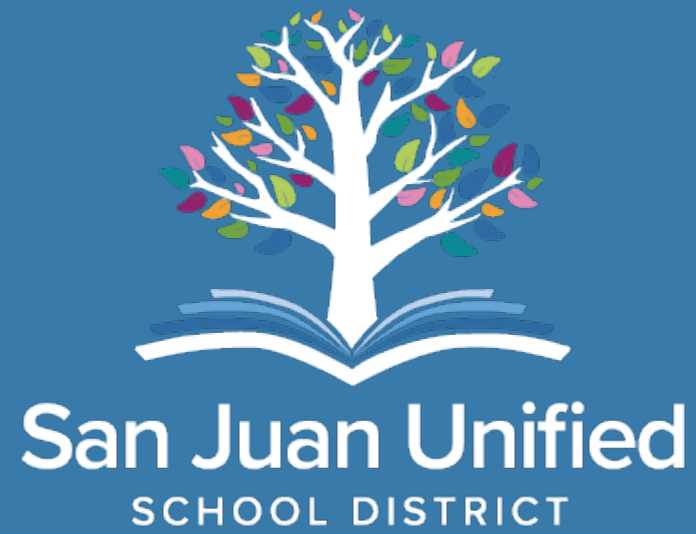
