These skills will create independent learners by fostering students' research, information literacy, technology, communication, and critical thinking skills. It is of equal importance to instill a need to read for pleasure.

The Library 5 to 11 course is divided into two essential units, which the student must master. There are additional selective units, which can be pursued optionally as a class or as individual enrichment. Librarians are encouraged to work in collaboration with classroom teachers to have the greatest impact on the student achievement.
