Success Story Summary

Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD) educates students in the Truckee and north Lake Tahoe areas. The district has 12 schools including five elementary schools, two middle schools, two comprehensive high schools, and three alternative educational options. WESCO's Government team and Reno branch worked with the District's Sustainability and Project Manager to assist with an LED Lighting Retrofit project utilizing Proposition 39 funds.

Proposition 39 California Clean Energy Jobs Act is a state program providing funding to local educational agencies for improving energy efficiency and creating clean energy jobs.

This project at TTUSD focused on replacing the fluorescent lights with energy-efficient LED lighting at several schools including the District Office. The improvements will save the district on their annual energy costs, generate one-time rebates from two local utilities, as well as save the District on maintenance costs over the next 15-20 years on lamp replacements.

WESCO's Regional Government Specialist facilitated project implementation through the National IPA cooperative contract.
