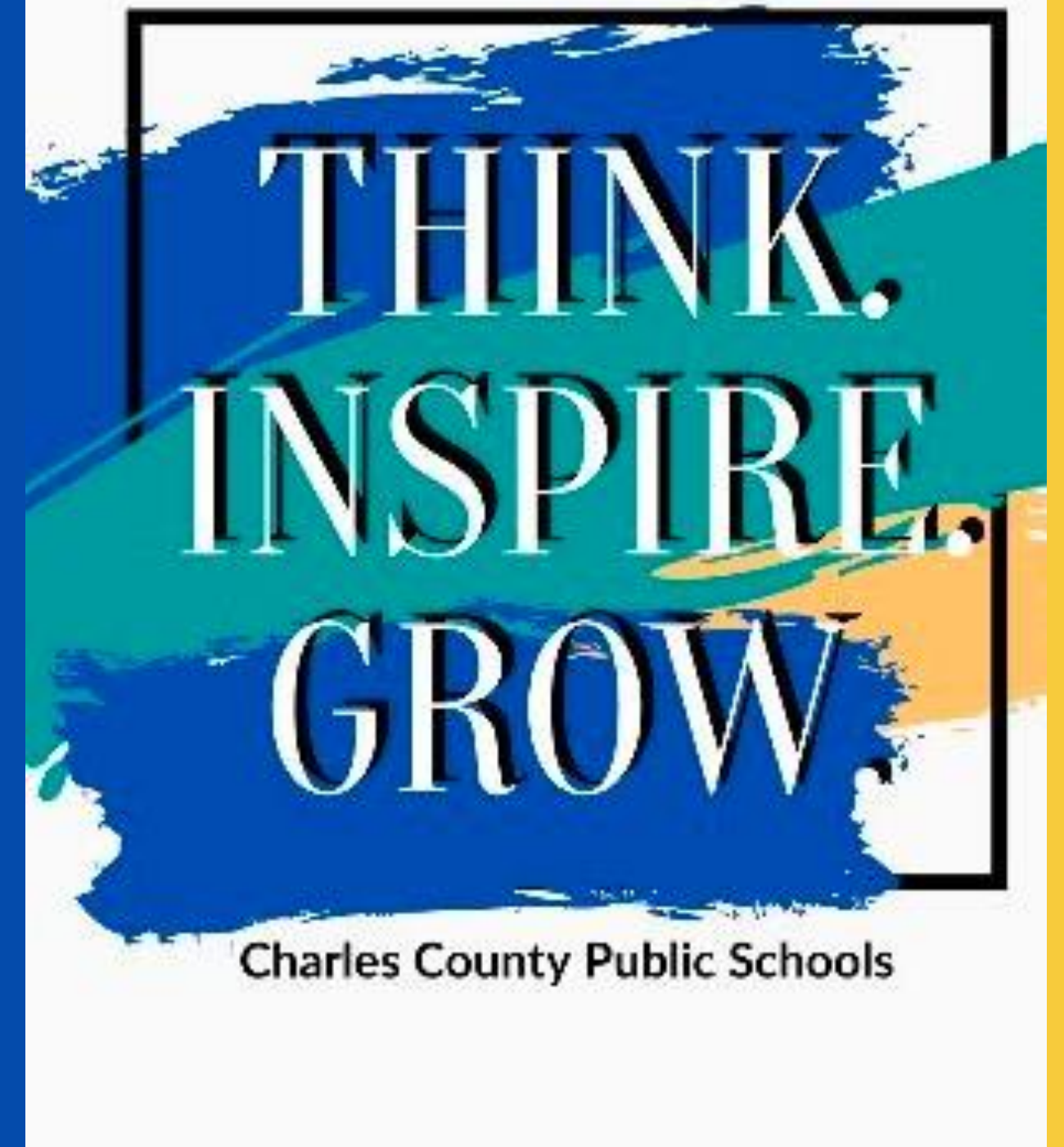


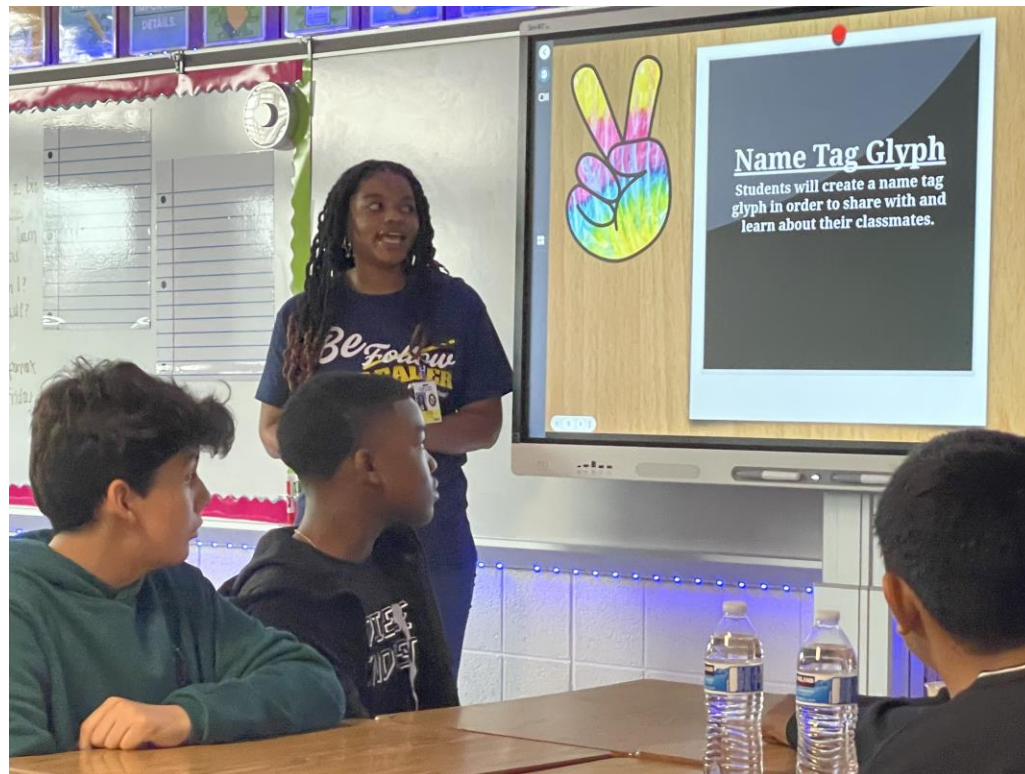

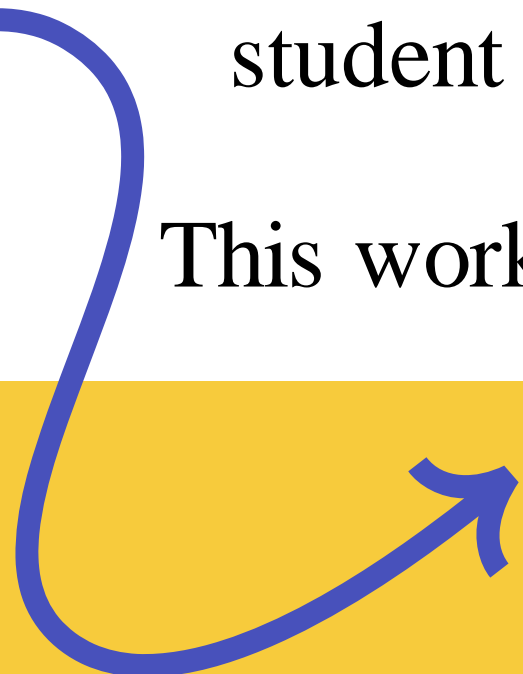


# School Improvement

School Improvement is a decision-making model that schools utilize to ensure programming, teaching and learning, and culture and community, provide all students access, opportunity, and support to achieve at high levels.

Each school develops a School Improvement Plan (SIP). The SIP identifies priority goals, instructional and culture strategies, and supports that schools will implement to raise student achievement and prepare students for college and career pathways.

This work starts in the elementary school and continues through high school.



# Student Learning & Achievement Writing

- **Data Summary:** On a county-wide common assessment, 40% of students scored a 0 or 1 for Written Expression using the established rubric. A score of 3 is considered proficient.
- **Goal:** By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, the percentage of students scoring a 0 or 1 on the Written Expression measure of the ELA Common Assessment will decrease from 40% to 35%.

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# Student Learning & Achievement Mathematics

## Data Summary:

Current Algebra 1 enrollment is 78 students. 45% of all students and 88% of students with disabilities were designated as beginning learners on the MCAP Math assessment.

## Goals:

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, 10% more students will be enrolled in Algebra 1 for the following school year.

The percentage of all students designated as beginning learners in math will decrease from 45% to 40% on MCAP.

The percentage of students with disabilities designated as beginning learners in math will decrease from 88% to 83% on MCAP.

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# School Climate and Culture

- **Data Summary:** Between September 1, 2022, and May 1, 2023, there were 77 out-of-school suspensions.
- **Goal:** By May 1, 2024, the number of out-of-school suspensions will decrease by 20%, from 77 to 61.

  - Long-term ISI



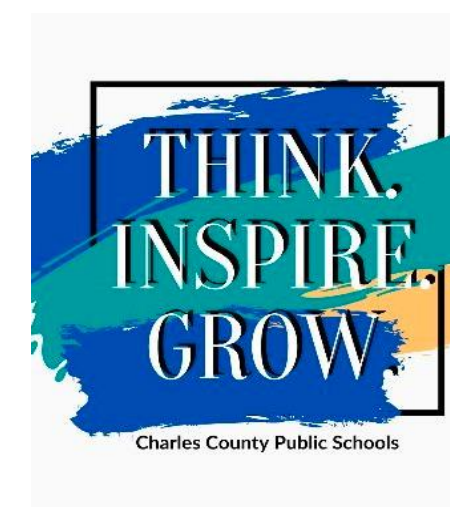
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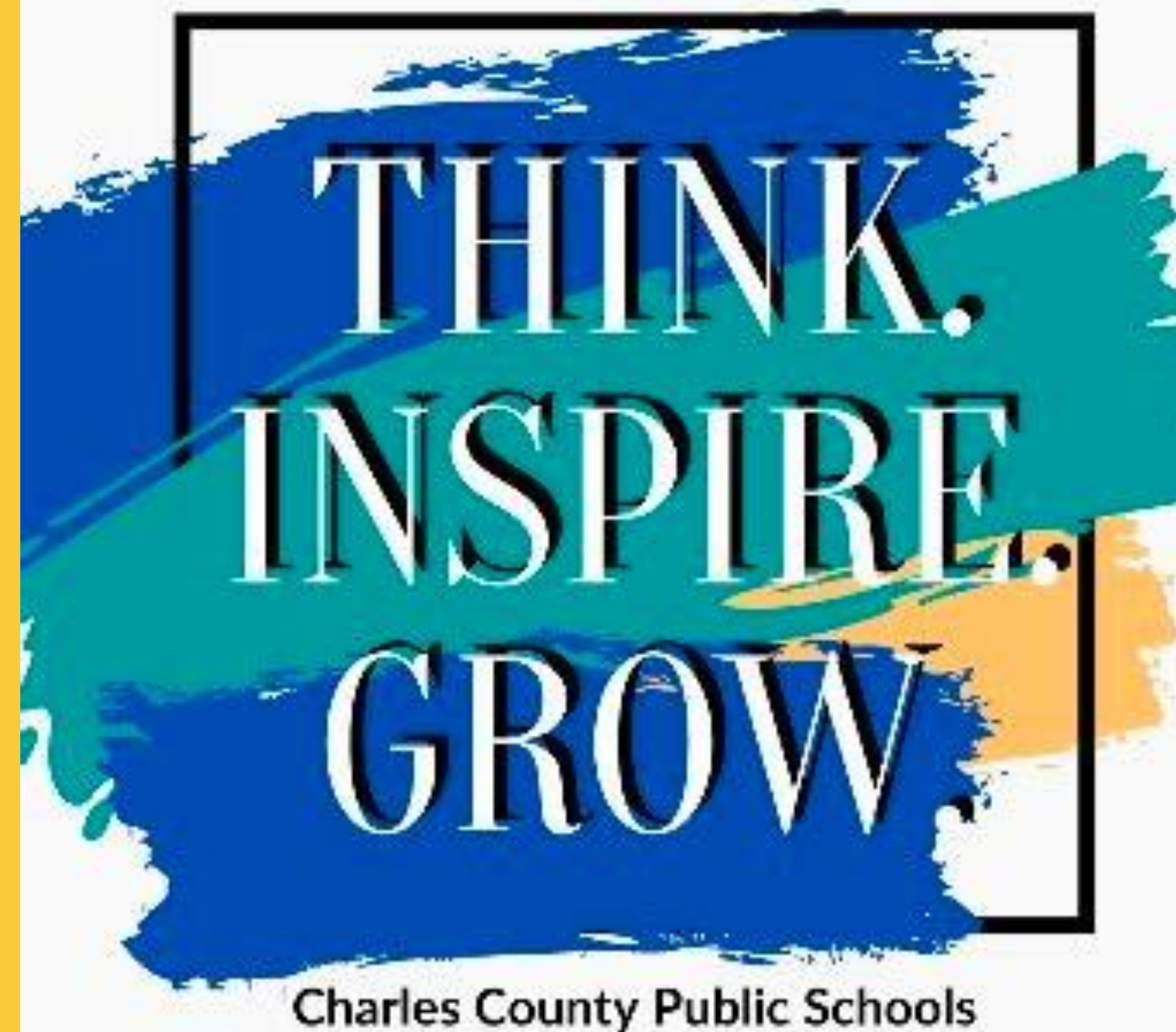
