RAINN

RAINN (Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network) is the largest anti-sexual violence organization in the United States. RAINN operates the National Sexual Assault Hotline (1-800-656-HOPE) in collaboration with more than 1,000 local sexual assault service providers nationwide. They also manage the DoD Safe Helpline, specifically supporting Department of Defense personnel. In addition to providing these critical services, RAINN implements programs aimed at preventing sexual violence, supporting survivors, and working to ensure that perpetrators face justice (RAINN, 2023).
