Chaska Intramural Basketball Rules

ROSTER INFORMATION: Each team may have ONE person, who is not a player, perform the duties of a coach. A roster must have a minimum of five players and a maximum of (10) players. All additions to the roster must be approved by the Athletic Office prior to the person playing with the team. Only players that are on the team roster are allowed to play: **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

CAPTAINS are responsible for turning in a team roster, which includes a team name and individual jersey sizes. Captains are also responsible for turning in the entire team's participation fee. Captains must also collect a signed rule sheet for each player on their roster.

Teams need at least four players on the court to start the game to avoid an automatic forfeiture of the game. Games will start immediately at the stated start time. No player may play as a member on two teams. No player will be permitted to transfer from one team to another.

SCORE: Each team manager, coach, or captain must report the score at the end of the game to Paige Hinze or Brenda Lentz.

JERSEY: Every participant must wear their team's official intramural jersey (or matching jersey). First choice of colors goes to whoever turns in their complete roster first.

No one that is on the roster of the high school team (grade 9-12) is allowed to play.

No spectators will be allowed on the gym floor. All non-participants will watch from the balcony overlooking the gym.

SCORING: Games will be scored by the home team. Games will be two 17 minute halves, running clock, and a 3 minute half time. Game can end in a tie, unless it is playoffs – during playoffs there will be a 3-minute overtime.

RULES: Three-point baskets will be allowed. No dunking or hanging on the rim or net. Once a player calls a foul, there is no debate. Teams must decide prior to the game if they are going to pass a ball in or start at the top of the key after a foul is made. This rule must be followed the entire game. In a jump ball situation, the ball goes back to whichever team had the ball last.

Any fighting, foul language, etc. will result in the immediate end to the game with both teams receiving a loss. If the infraction is severe enough, teams or individuals may be removed for the remainder of the intramural season.
