PSAT/NMSQT

On October 19, ALL Juniors will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT at no cost. The school will be covering the cost of the exam. This is our commitment and investment to give our students experience in taking high-stakes tests that they will come across in their future. A successful score on the PSAT/NMSQT also gives students the opportunity to earn recognition and scholarships through the National Merit Scholarship program just like BigFuture above.

[If you do not want your student taking the exam, please let us know.](#) It is a logistical challenge for us to put this test together, so having an accurate count of students is important.

Attention Juniors!

On October 19th, all Juniors will be taking the PSAT at no cost to you! HHS is paying for ALL grade 11 students to take this test.

The PSAT/NMSQT

The PSAT/NMSQT is now digital! The test is easier to take, shorter, has more time per question, and comes with a built-in calculator. It can also qualify you for the National Merit Scholarship Program and other scholarships.

Buy AP Tests Now

Purchase your AP tests NOW! The due date is October 31 and the cost for each test is \$99. Students will not be turned away for financial reasons. Don't let this opportunity to earn college credit pass you by!

• June 10 - Pick up diplomas in the Field House (open from 8am to 12:00pm). Diplomas will not be given out after graduation ceremony, so if you cannot be there on June 10, please let us know.
• In addition to diplomas, graduating seniors can pick up a copy of their yearbook transcript on Monday, June 10th. One copy of graduating senior official transcript will be available for pick up in the Main Office starting Tuesday, June 11th through Friday, June 15th - when the high school office closes for the summer. They can be requested at the district office during the summer when the high school office is closed.
• If a graduate needs to make their diploma request, please complete a request for transcript form (available in the Main Office) and return it to the Main Office by June 10th.
• Running shoes and athletic gear (sweat suits, etc.) are available for purchase. These items will arrive later in June in accordance with those outdoor gearing guidelines. All orders are made to order these items as quickly as possible once received at HHS.

Required High School and Beyond Plan - Seniors, this is a graduation requirement in our state. Check with your counselor to ensure that you are up to date.

Anticipation Society - Did you want a scholarship for your hard work? We want to reward! Click on the link to complete the survey. **Save evening!**

Caps and Gowns - Caps and Gowns will be distributed to seniors in early May.

AP Cards - If you took an AP test during your time at HHS, you can use an AP credit at graduation. If you're a senior, you can use an AP credit to help pay for your college education.

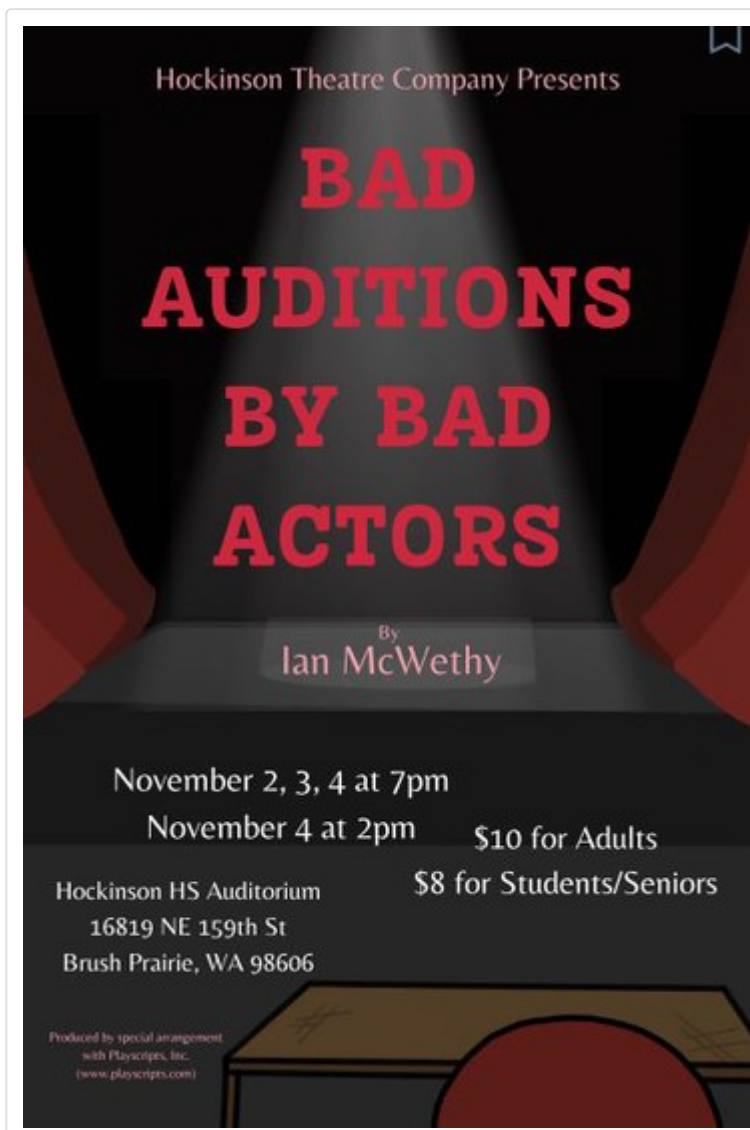

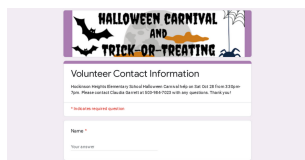
