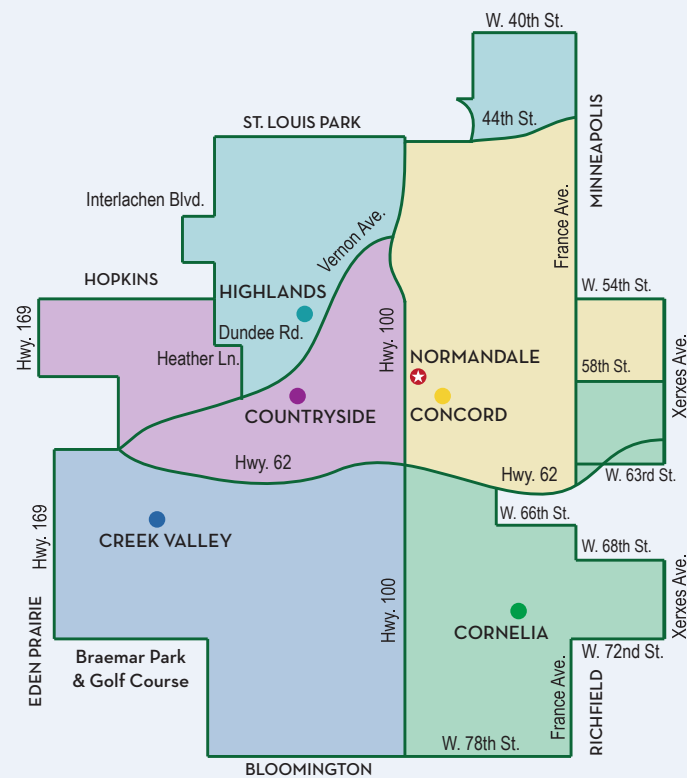

## Schedule your child's screening

Early Childhood Screening is a quick and easy way to check in on your child's health and development and connect them to amazing early childhood programming before they begin kindergarten. **All Minnesota children must complete an early childhood screening before attending kindergarten regardless of the school or school district they attend.** This screening is a check of the child's development, vision, hearing, growth, health history and immunizations. Screening can help identify any concerns or issues early and access resources if needed.

# Get Ready for Kindergarten!

Your guide to enrolling your child in fall 2024 kindergarten



## ENROLLING— Easy as 1-2-3!

If your child will turn five years old on or before September 1, 2024, they are eligible to enroll in fall 2024 kindergarten.

- 1 Learn about our kindergarten programs.** Reading this guide is your first step. Schedule a tour for schools that interest you. Visit the school websites. Talk to families who attend our schools.
- 2 Complete the online Choice Program form.** If you are interested in one of our three choice programs, **complete the online choice form by Jan. 5, 2024, at 4pm**, available at [edinaschools.org/kindergarten](https://edinaschools.org/kindergarten). Enrollment is determined through a lottery process. All choice forms received by the deadline are treated equally, with no benefit given to those submitted earlier than others. Completing a preference form does not guarantee placement in the program. Families will be notified of their enrollment status via email on Jan. 12.
- 3 Enroll your child online** during the enrollment window: **Jan. 15-26, 2024.** Visit [edinaschools.org/kindergarten](https://edinaschools.org/kindergarten) to complete your child's enrollment. **This step is for all families**, regardless of whether their child will attend a neighborhood school or choice program.

If you know that your child **will not be enrolling** in the Edina Public Schools for fall 2024 kindergarten, please call our Enrollment Center at 952-848-4585 so we can update our records. Thank you!

### NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Five neighborhood elementary schools are located throughout Edina, providing an excellent education and personalized learning in a welcoming environment close to home. While each school has its own personality, all of our elementary schools use the same high-quality curriculum and innovative teaching methods to nurture students in their early years and prepare them for their later years.

All of our neighborhood schools serve children in kindergarten through grade five and offer:

- A warm and welcoming community of students, staff and parents
- A personalized learning experience
- High expectations for all
- Support that helps students achieve at their highest potential
- Core academic learning and social-emotional development
- Specialized instruction in art, music and physical education
- Recent building enhancements that create flexible learning spaces that offer students creative and innovative opportunities to learn and grow

### CHOICE PROGRAMS

In addition to our outstanding neighborhood schools, Edina Public Schools offers three choice programs available to families throughout the district. Families must complete an online choice form to request one of these programs; final selection is made through a lottery. If families do not receive their choice, they will be warmly welcomed in their neighborhood school.

#### French Immersion / Normandale Elementary

This program immerses students in a second language while they learn all subjects in French. Normandale follows the same curriculum used at our English speaking schools. Students not only learn a new language, but also acquire a greater understanding, knowledge and appreciation of the cultures who speak the language. Because of the advancing skill level each year, entrance is most successful in kindergarten.

#### Spanish Dual Language / Countryside Elementary

This program includes both native Spanish speakers and native English speakers in the same classroom so students have the ability to learn both languages together. Students not only learn a new language, but also acquire a greater understanding, knowledge and appreciation of the cultures who speak the language. Because of the advancing skill level each year, entrance is most successful in kindergarten.

#### Continuous Progress / Highlands Elementary

This multi-age program is focused on developing meaningful long-term relationships with both students and families. A team of two or three teachers and a group of students stay together throughout elementary school, making students part of a multi-age educational family.

While the Continuous Progress program does not begin until second grade, we recommend families enroll in kindergarten to avoid changing schools.

## WHOLE CHILD LEARNING

### Discover the wonders of kindergarten in Edina Public Schools!

Our kindergarten program exposes our littlest Hornets to a robust kindergarten curriculum while learning through play, fostering social-emotional development and sparking curiosity that sets the foundation for being a lifelong learner.

Families can enroll in their neighborhood school close to home or in one of our three choice programs: French Immersion, Spanish Dual Language or Continuous Progress.
