## NOTIFICATION OF RIGHT TO REQUEST TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

Mercer County Schools receives federal funds for Title I and Title II programs as a part of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB). Under NCLB, parents have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's teacher(s). If parents request this information, the district will provide the following:

1. Whether the teacher has met the state requirements for licensure and certification for the grade levels and subject matters in which the teacher provides instruction;

2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;

3. The college major and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree;

4. Whether your child is provided services by paraeducators, and if so, their qualifications.
