Here are some important reminders:

From the school nurse



COVID-19 will likely be with us as an ongoing endemic disease with emerging variants and seasonal fluctuations in cases. The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has shared COVID-19 Reminders for Parents to provide everyday steps to ensure everyone has access to healthy and safe learning spaces.

Stay home when sick, and reach out to your health care provider to discuss testing and treatment options if you think you might have COVID-19 (e.g., you know you have been exposed to COVID-19, or know that COVID-19 is circulating in your community, school, or family and you have symptoms). If you think you may have COVID-19, avoid interacting with anyone who is more likely to develop severe disease.

Though older adults have the highest risk for severe illness, some children may have medical conditions that increase their risk.

Public health recommends isolation as an important strategy to control the spread of COVID-19 in the community, schools, and child care settings. People with COVID-19 symptoms should stay home. If you test positive or think you have COVID-19 (for example, if you feel sick and you've recently been exposed to someone with COVID-19), isolate at home for five full days after your positive test or the start of your symptoms. Wear a mask around others for five full days after that. If you test negative, you can end isolation.

If unable to stay home for five days, wear a mask, especially around those who may be at risk of severe disease (grandparents, residents living in long-term care, etc.).

Stay home any time you're sick, even if you know it's not COVID-19, for at least 24 hours after your fever resolves without fever-reducing medications and your other symptoms are improving.

You can find more information on COVID-related illness and other common illnesses and guidelines for school attendance in CDPHE's How Sick is Too Sick and through your school's health team.
