CURRICULUM

UWC Thailand uses the International Baccalaureate as its educational framework.

As a fully authorised International Baccalaureate Continuum School, UWC Thailand offers the Primary Years Programme from Pre-Kindergarten to grade 5, Middle Years Programme from grades 6 to 10 and the Diploma Programme from grades 11 to 12. International Baccalaureate Diploma students complete six subjects, three at standard and three at higher level.


Students also study Theory of Knowledge, submit an Extended Essay and participate in Creativity, Activity and Service programmes.

There are 18 member schools across the globe who all share the UWC mission and values.



UNIVERSITY COUNSELLING

Like our student body profile, post-secondary educational options are many and varied. Many students are clear they wish to attend university, and are determined to pursue a specific course of study. Others want to attend university though have no idea what to study, or where. Each year we also have a few students who decide to pursue different goals, be that obtaining a certification in network engineering, joining the military, working or traveling during a purpose year, or vocational training. We are keen to support each student's aims and do our utmost to facilitate their transition from UWC Thailand to the next part of their educational journey.

UNIVERSITY ADVISING POLICIES

- Students are limited to ten applications worldwide.
- Recommendations and testimonials are kept confidential.
- UWC Thailand does not compute GPA or rank students.
- UWC Thailand does not provide any formal preparation for standardised tests such as the SAT, ACT, and TOEFL.

OUR CLASS OF 2023 GRADUATES

The average International Baccalaureate score for the UWC Thailand 2023 graduates who successfully completed the International Baccalaureate diploma was 34, compared to a worldwide average of 30.24 as of July 2023. Our graduates are change-makers with a depth of character, grit, and initiative.

The predominant destination for our students remains the USA largely due to the Davis United World College Scholars Programme that provides scholarships for UWC graduates to 98 colleges and universities in the USA. Our cohort of Diploma Programme graduates earns an average of US\$7 million annually for university attendance worldwide.

Our graduates have matriculated to colleges and universities in Canada, France, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Singapore, Spain, UK, and USA, amongst others.
