CURRICULUM

UWC Thailand uses the International Baccalaureate as its educational framework.

As a fully authorised International Baccalaureate Continuum School, UWC Thailand offers the Primary Years Programme from Pre-Kindergarten to grade 5, Middle Years Programme from grades 6 to 10 and the Diploma Programme from grades 11 to 12. International Baccalaureate Diploma students complete six subjects, three at standard and three at higher level.

Students also study Theory of Knowledge, submit an Extended Essay and participate in Creativity, Activity and Service programmes.

NATIONAL COMMITTEE SELECTED STUDENTS

Students can apply to one of the 18 UWC's through their country's National Committee, and can be awarded a needs-based scholarship to attend a UWC by showing their alignment to the movement's mission and philosophy.

UWC Thailand welcomes students from around the world, from a variety of socioeconomic backgrounds, to come and study the 2-year Diploma Programme.

There are 18 member schools across the globe who all share the UWC mission and values.

UNIVERSITY COUNSELLING

Like our student body profile, post-secondary educational options are diverse. Many students are clear about their desire to attend university and are determined to pursue a specific course of study. Others wish to attend university but are unsure of what to study or where to go. Each year, we also have a few students who decide to pursue different goals, such as obtaining a certification in network engineering, joining the military, working or traveling during a gap year, or vocational training. We are committed to supporting each student's aspirations and do our utmost to facilitate their transition from UWC Thailand to the next part of their educational journey.

- UWC Thailand does not provide any formal preparation for standardised tests such as the SAT, ACT, and TOEFL.

OUR CLASS OF 2024 GRADUATES

At UWC Thailand, our true measure of success is how we help create incredible human beings who live our mission and motto. Academic success, demonstrated by each student achieving their best, is one important measure of this. We are pleased to celebrate that the average International Baccalaureate score for the UWC Thailand 2024 graduates who successfully completed the International Baccalaureate diploma was 30.5, compared to a worldwide average of 30.3 as of August 2024. Our graduates are change-makers with a depth of character, grit, and initiative that will help them make the world more peaceful and sustainable.

The predominant destination for our students remains the USA, largely due to the Davis United World College Scholars Programme, which provides scholarships for UWC graduates to attend 100 colleges and universities in the USA. Our cohort of Diploma Programme graduates earns an average of US\$7 million annually in scholarships for university attendance worldwide. Our graduates have matriculated to colleges and universities in Canada, France, Italy, Japan, the Netherlands, Singapore, Spain, the UK, and the USA, among others.
