# Digital PSAT/NMSQT Assessment

October 11, 2023

- ★ 1106 of the 1148 (96%) students took the digital exam.
- ★ Most students arrived ready for the exam with charged iPads, etc.
- ★ No testing delays due to technology.
- ★ All students with accommodations were able to test in one day.
- ★ No exam submission errors.
- ★ Improvements will include: rearranging the field house to create shorter rows, generate a detailed task list for row proctors, create additional visuals to support students with the pre-exam administration steps, provide substitute teachers with Stevenson devices.

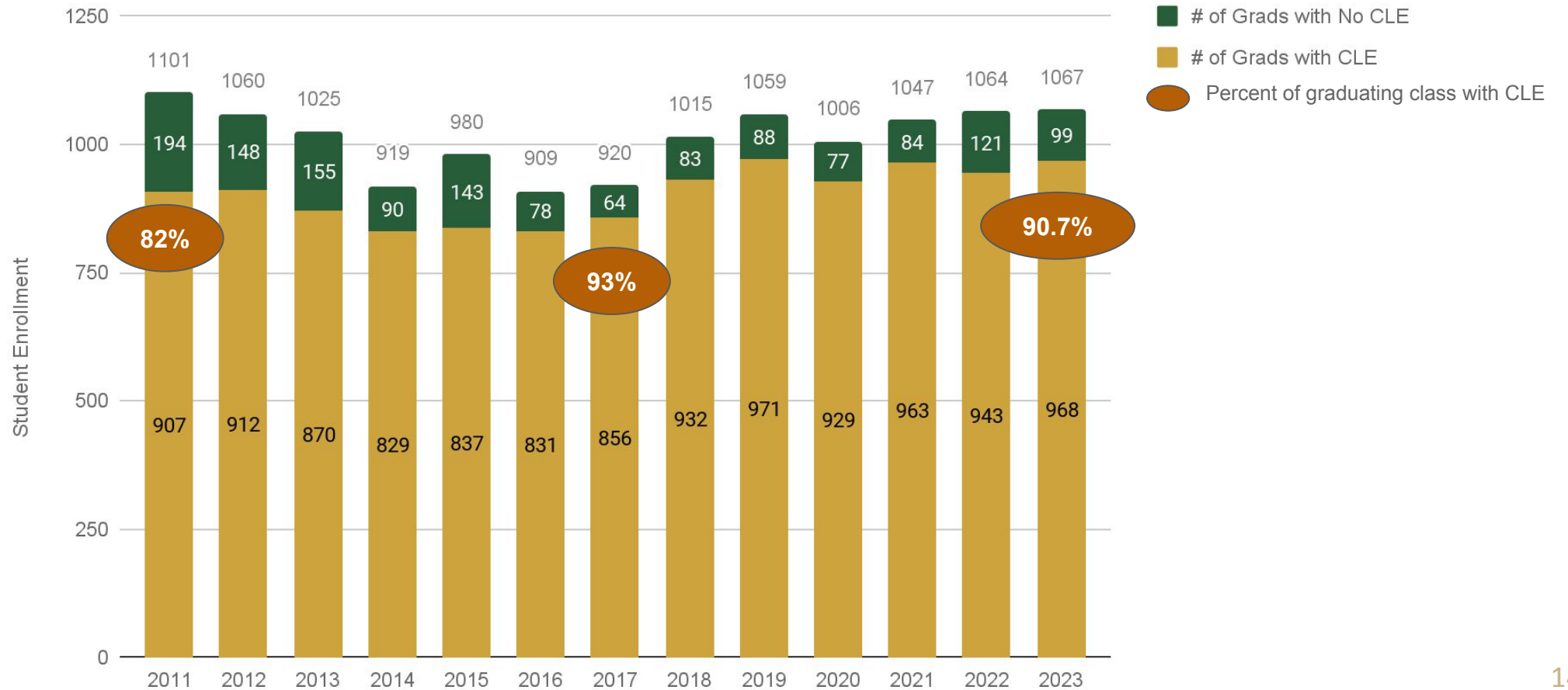

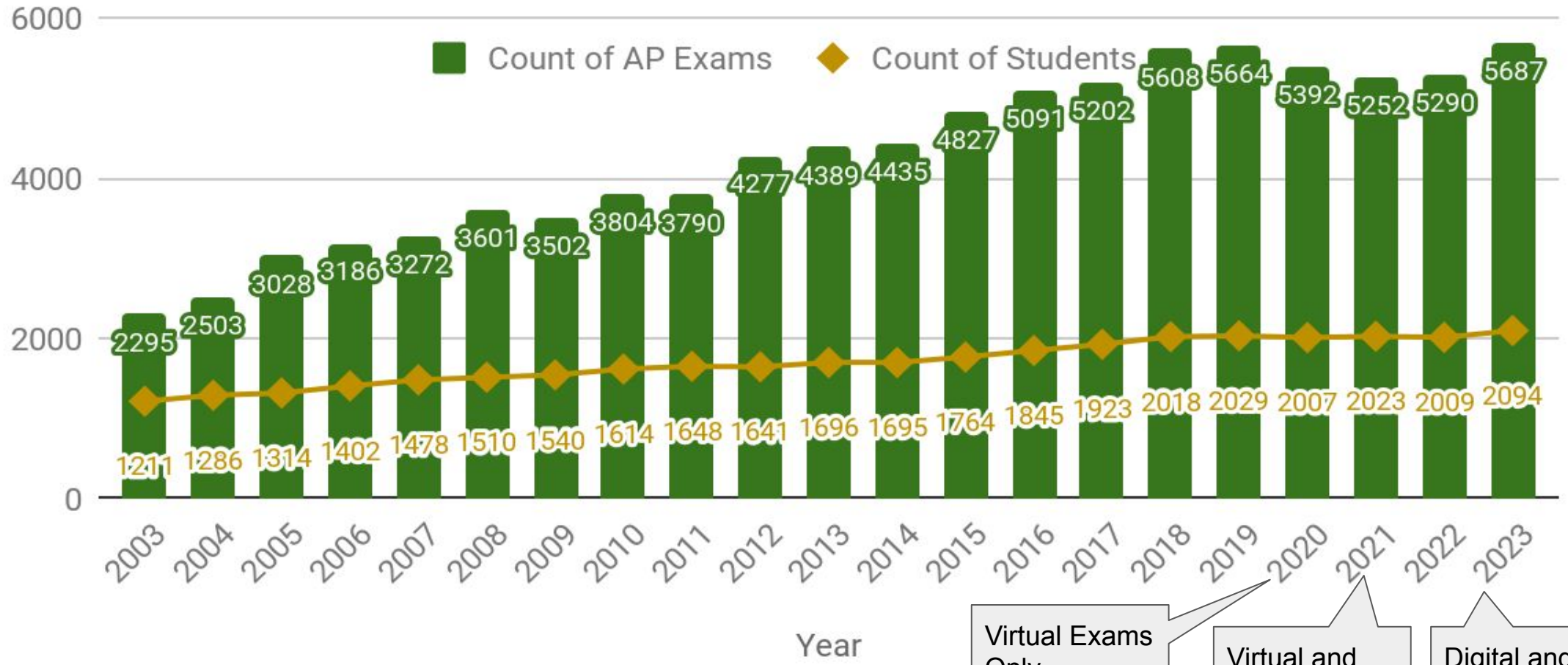

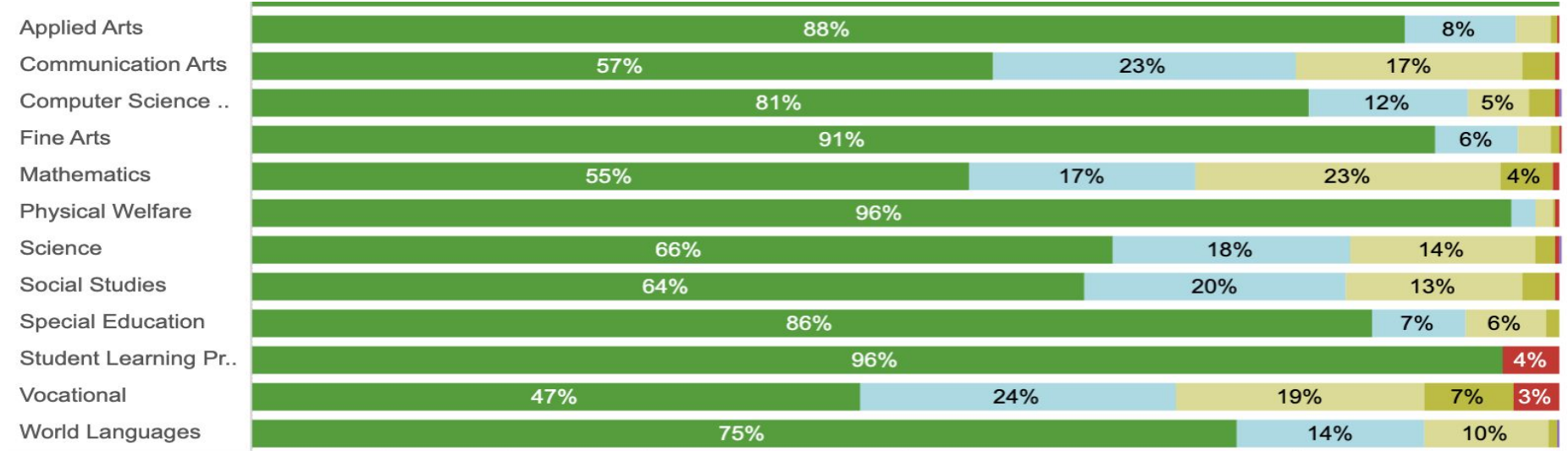

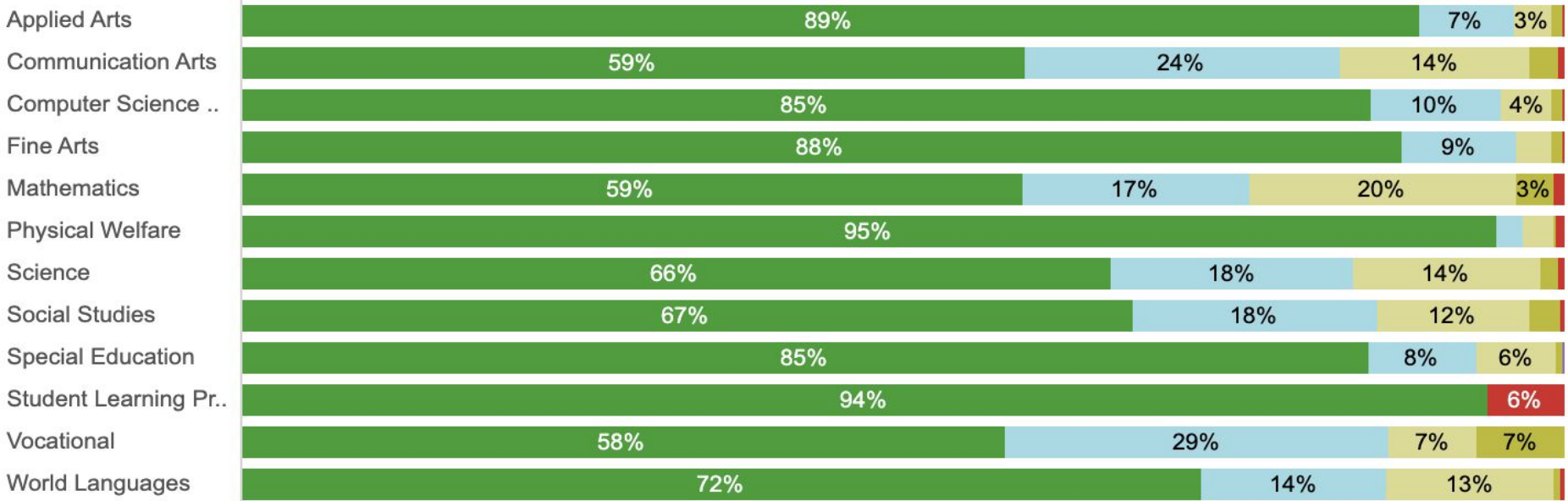


# Sem 1 Final Grade Distribution by Division

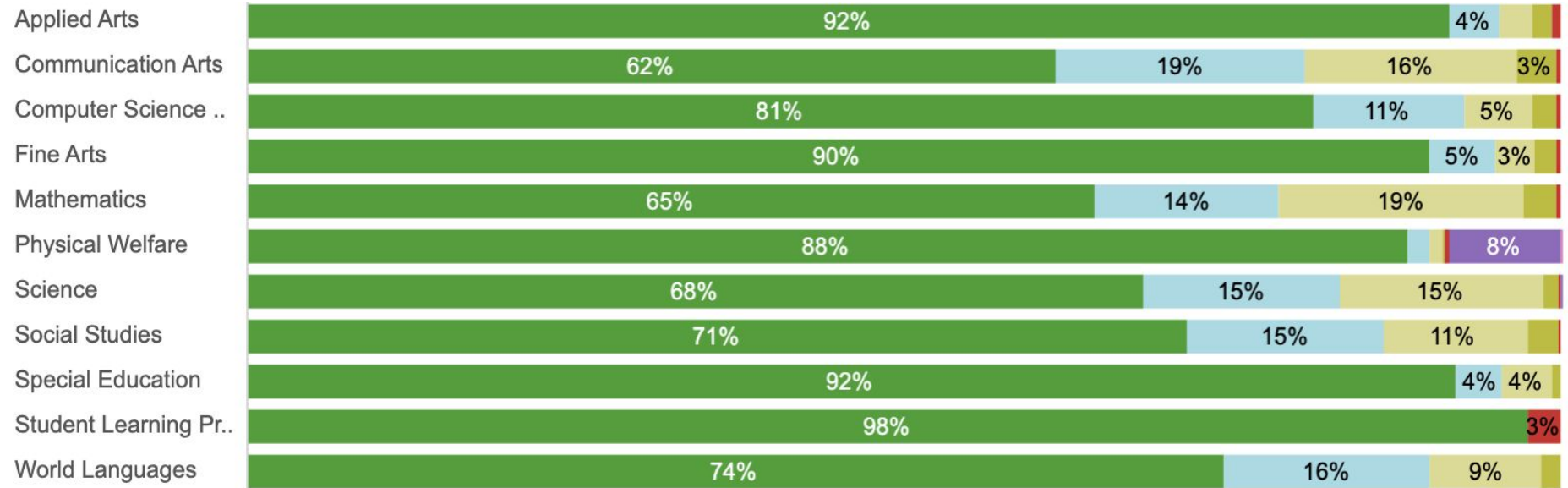
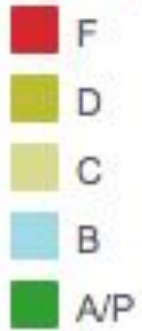

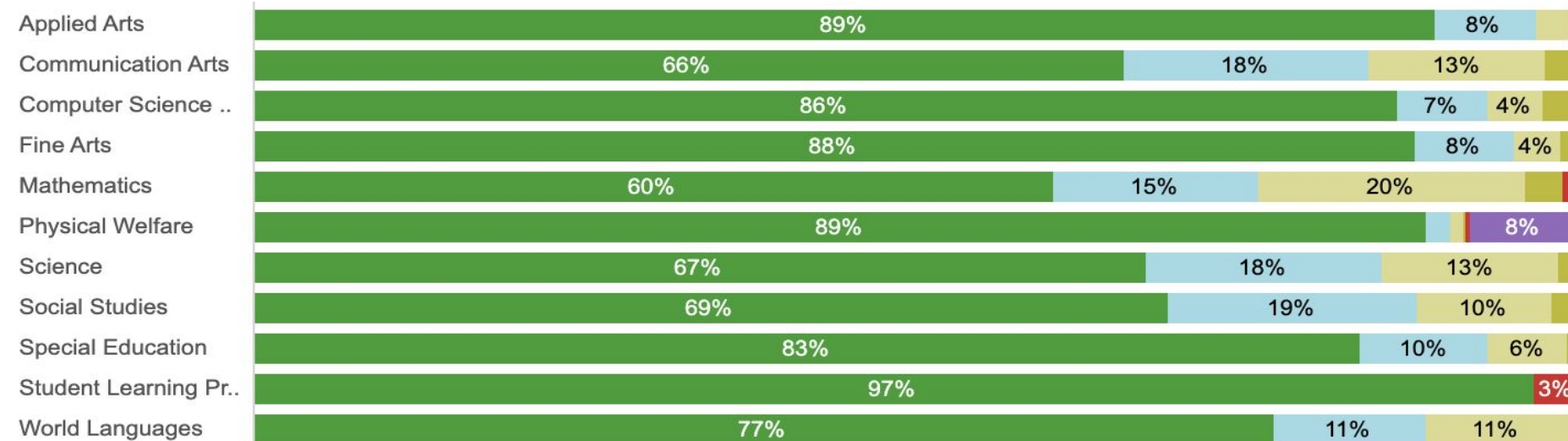


# Sem 2 Final Grade Distribution by Division

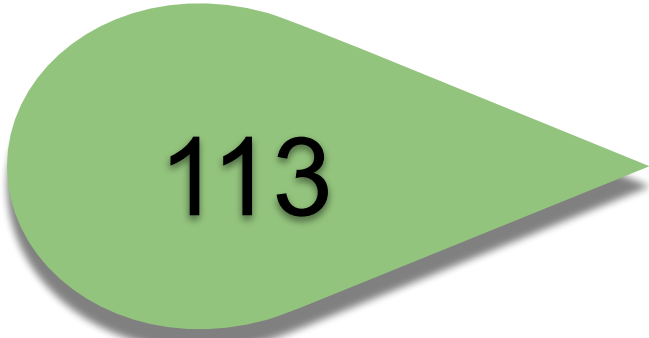

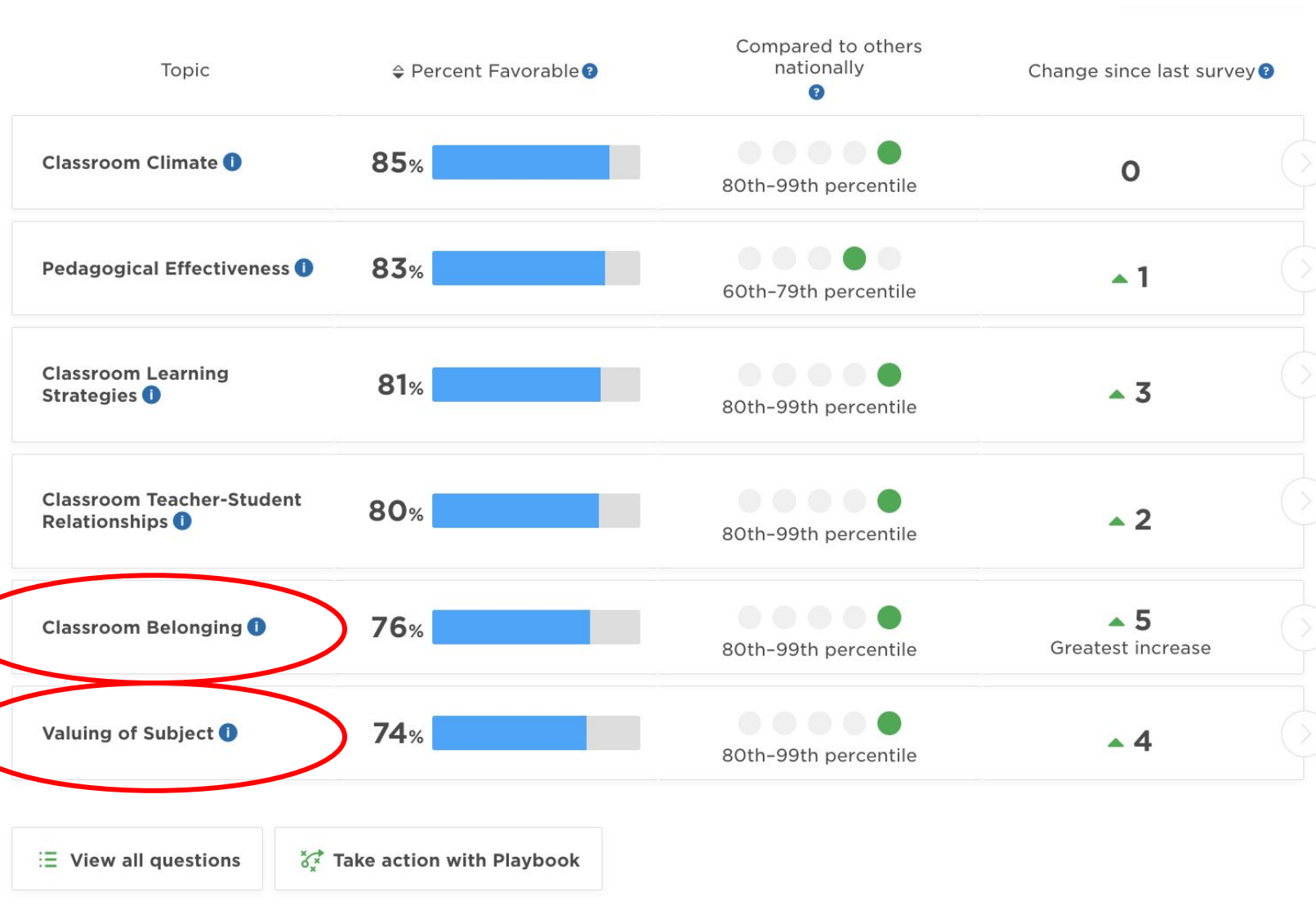

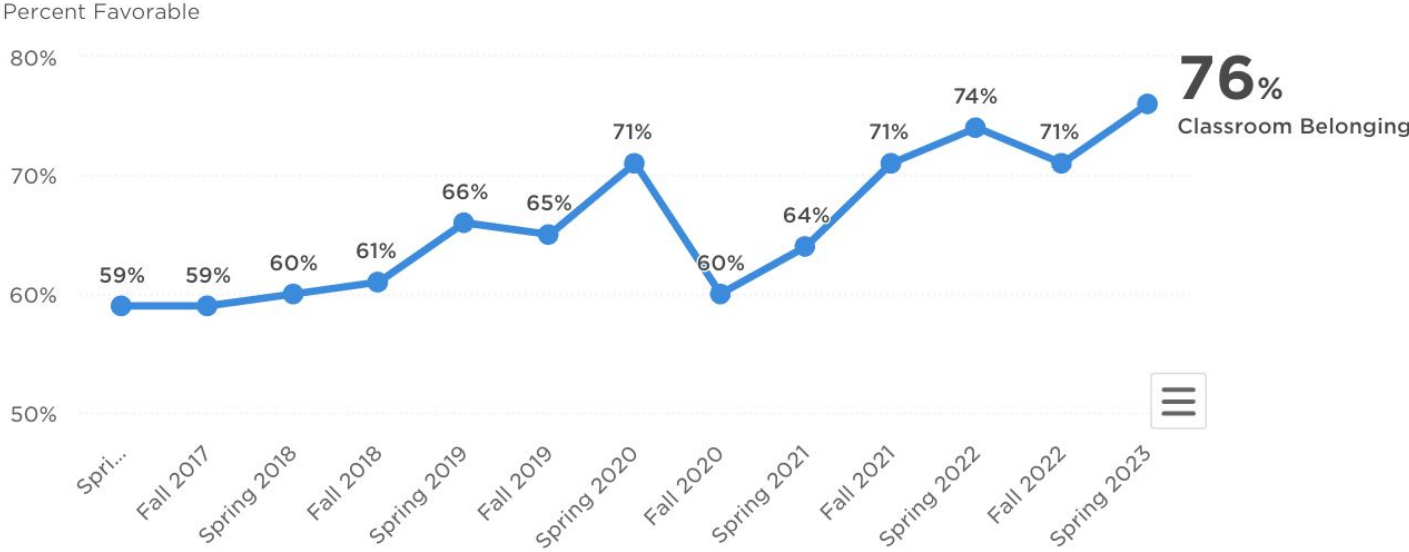

How have results changed over time?

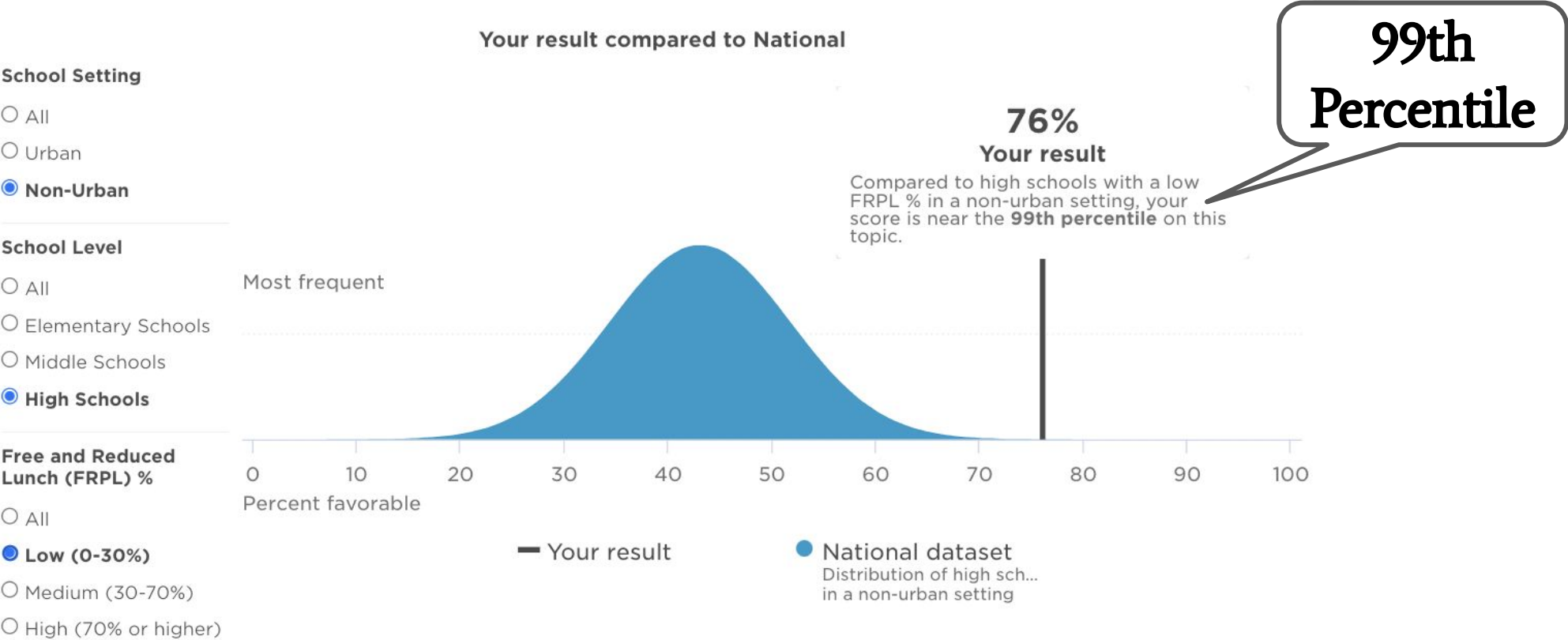

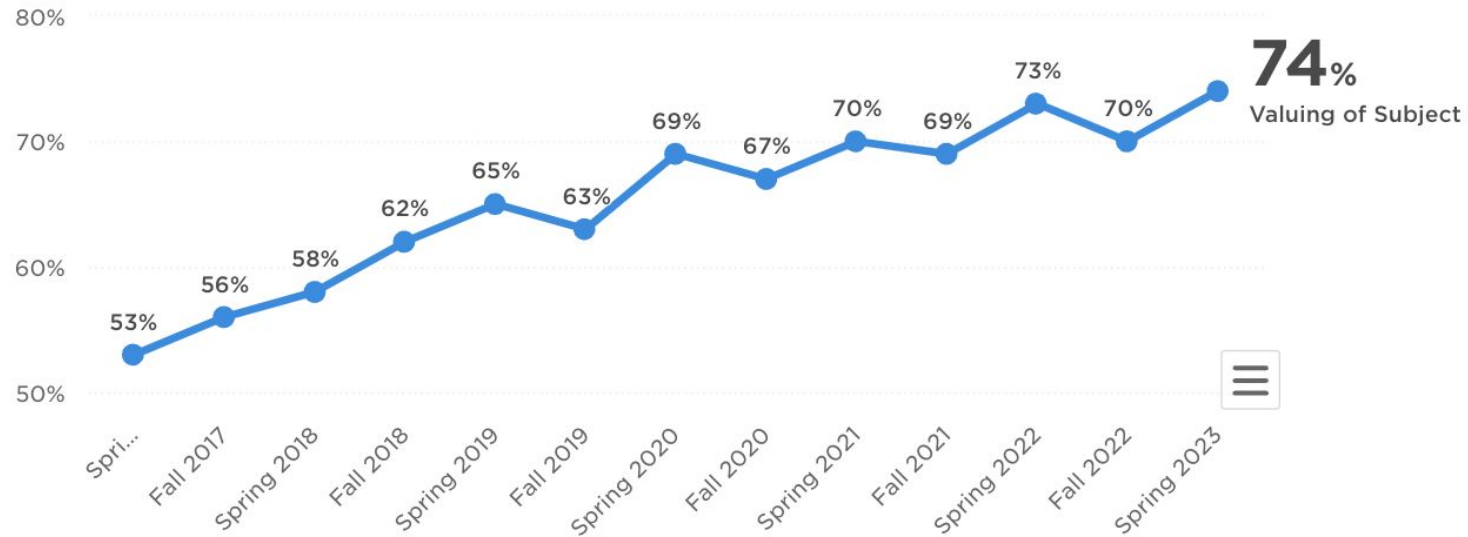

Percent Favorable

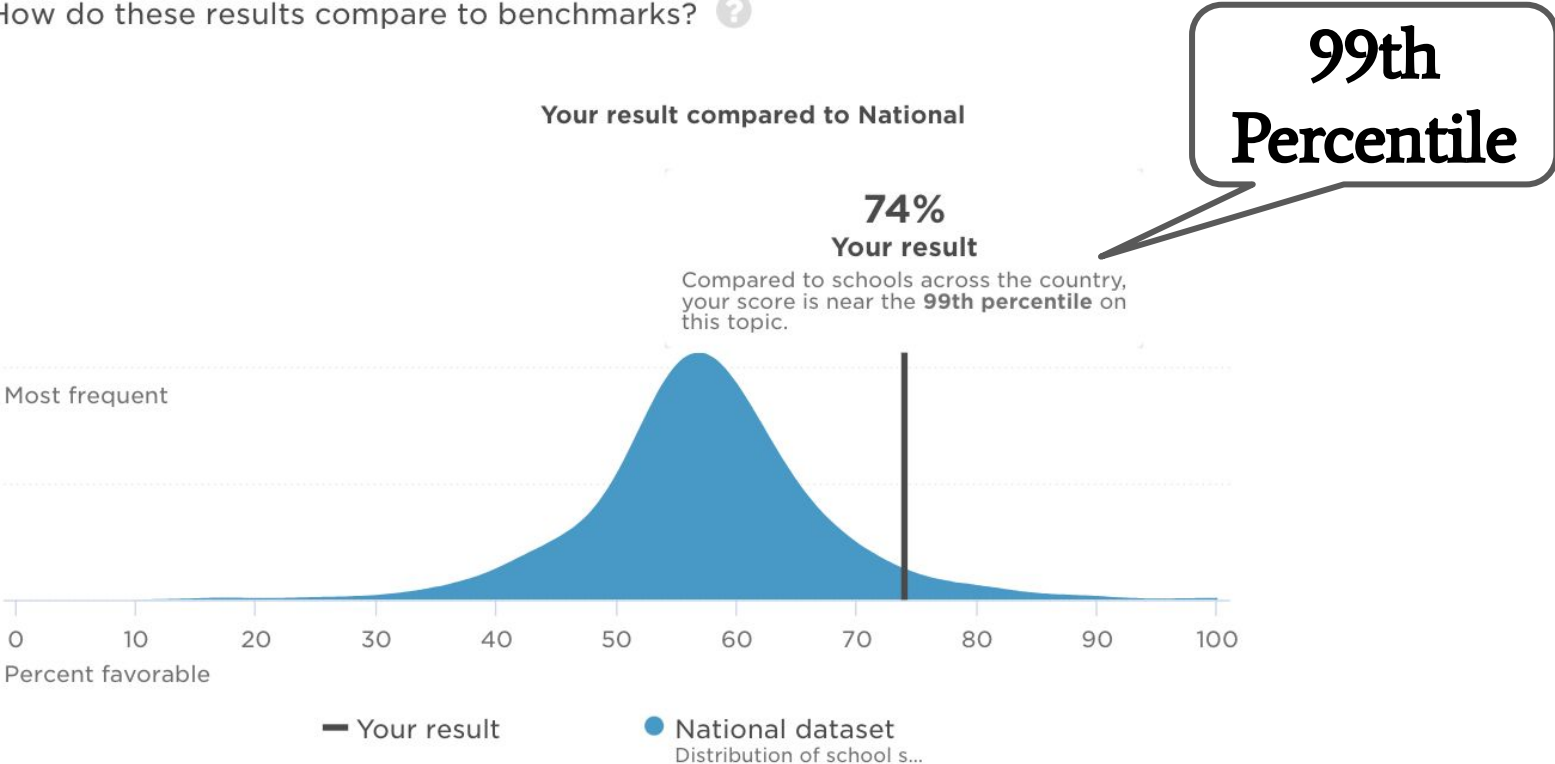
