### **Expanded Business Sectors Closed**

Date: July 1, 2020  
Effective: July 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

California is experiencing record-breaking increases in the number of new cases and hospitalizations related to the spread of COVID-19. To slow the spread of the virus, on June 28, 2020, the California Department of Public Health (“CDPH”) mandated the closure of bars and similar businesses in counties on the County Monitoring List, including Kings County which has been listed for more than 14 days. In addition, on July 1, 2020, CDPH further mandated the closure of additional specific business sectors in those counties.

As directed by the CDPH, and under the authority of California Health and Safety Code sections 101030, 101040, 101085, and 120175; Title 17 California Code of Regulations Section 2501, Article XI of the California Constitution, California Government Code Sections 8610, 8630, 8634, and 8665; and Kings County Code of Ordinances Section 6-11, the Health Officer of the County of Kings has ordered that the following business sectors will close indoor operations and, if possible, move to outdoor services only until further notice:

- Indoor Dine-in restaurants
- Indoor Wineries and Tasting Rooms
- Indoor Family Entertainment Centers(bowling alleys, miniature golf, batting cages, and arcades)
- Indoor Movie Theaters
- Indoor Zoos and Museums
- Indoor Cardrooms

All business sectors listed above must comply with the Health Officer’s Order by Thursday, July 2, 2020, at 5:00pm. Failure to comply may result in license revocation, fines, legal costs and potential criminal penalties.
