he experience, creativity and commitment of DPCR's new academic leadership team brought stability and elevated expectations to the academic program. With planning and purpose around school events, extracurricular activities and new hires, a vibrant school culture flourished throughout the school year. Elevated expectations and opportunities brought an increase

in student attendance, honor roll achievement, extracurricular participation, and AP test scores. More than a third of the incoming freshman class participated in the first, voluntary summer bridge academic program. A group of current students completed summer college classes through a new College Credit Plus partnership with **Cincinnati State Technical and Community College.** In a year-long process, the academic team collaborated with students and staff to develop a Bruin at Grad profile based on the longheld student mantra: **Believe. Achieve. Become.** Articulated expectations and behaviors around these three tenets have been introduced this school year.

mplifying a culture of professionalism was a critical
priority of the Corporate Work Study Program's (CWSP)
new leaders and staff. They set a high bar and example
with new ideas, energy and commitment. Their high
expectations led to increased scores on student job
evaluations and highly satisfied on-the-job supervisors –
an overwhelming 98 percent of supervisors reported

that the program is meaningful for them. The CWSP continued to rebuild from the complete pandemic shutdown; this past year brought more student job placements, more partners, and a new transportation provider to improve reliability. There is still work to be done to reach pre-pandemic levels of full student employment and the addition of Discover CWSP lunch-and-learn events was a new, successful platform to host prospective partners.

ith the pandemic disruption mostly over, the Bruin community and culture roared back to life. New and renewed clubs and activities aligned with student interests brought a remarkable 90 percent of the student body into extracurricular participation. The Fine Arts program offered numerous field trips to

concerts, Broadway shows and museums, as well as student theater and talent show performances. Students worked all school year to produce DPCR's first docuseries, "The Comeback." There were Black and Hispanic Heritage Month celebrations, a Multicultural Festival, and two class trips to Washington, DC. Service was emphasized locally with student-led canned food and toy drives, as well as beyond campus with summer service trips to Nashville and South Dakota. Athletic opportunities also expanded with the addition of women's soccer and a more competitive track and field program that produced 19 new school records.




